

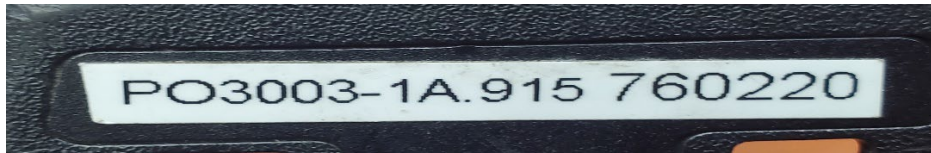

San Diego Police personnel previously utilized an 800 MHz Trunked Simulcast Radio Network. During the past several years, a new P25 Digital 700 MHz Simulcast Network has been designed, tested, and deployed. The 2<sup>nd</sup> touch programming moved it from the 800 MHz to the 700 MHz.

There are some Department members whose radios have yet to be reprogrammed. Members having radios that have yet to be reprogrammed will encounter frequency and transmission issues. Department members should check their radios making sure they have an updated sticker reading PP30AOX-1A.818. **If the attached radio's sticker ends with 818, NO ACTION IS NECESSARY. If it reads PP300X-1A.915, as shown below, your radio will not function properly and needs to be reprogrammed.**



Personnel needing their radios reprogrammed, shall either take their radio to Radio Shops or Operational Support for updating. If you have any questions, please contact the Operational Support Unit, at 619-531-2113.
