Portions of this document are deemed by the San Diego Police Department to be records of security procedures and are exempt from disclosure under the California Public Records Act (CPRA), Government Code Section 6254 (f).

The Annual Handgun and Patrol Rifle Qualification Shoot for Record began September 20, 2021 and was originally to conclude January 7, 2022. In an effort to maintain safe field staffing levels during the rise of Covid-19 cases, the Police Range was closed effective January 4, 2022. This closure prevented Department personnel, who had previously signed up on Success Factors, from completing the handgun and / or rifle qualification shoot.

The Police Range will re-open on Monday, February 7, 2022 to allow personnel the opportunity to complete the qualification shoot. This "make-up" period will be from February 7, 2022 until the close of business on Friday, February 18, 2022. During this time the Police Range will be open normal operational hours.

Department personnel who were unable to attend the qualification shoot due to the Covid-19 closure are required to attend during the above dates and achieve a passing score by February 18, 2022. Personnel who are still on Medical Leave during this time must contact the Police Range upon return to schedule the qualification shoot. Immediate supervisors will ensure their officers are scheduled and track their attendance. Dates and times for available shoots will be posted on the Department's Success Factors website. Personnel who arrive late will be required to reschedule for another shoot.

Duty ammunition will be shot for the qualification and replaced upon completion. The Firearm Proficiency Award Program will be in effect during this shoot. Shooters must score 195 or more points in the "A" and "C" zones only, with all rounds hitting the scoring area in their <u>first</u> attempt at the shoot to qualify for the award. Officers need to qualify annually for this award to

## wear the Pistol / Rifle Expert pin. Three magazines for a semi- automatic pistol are required for the handgun shoot.

Supervisors and officers working patrol and other uniformed assignments must wear their full duty equipment. Supervisors and officers working investigations and non-uniformed assignments, including authorized civilians, are expected to shoot with the holster that is worn in everyday use; non-uniformed assignments may NOT use patrol style leather gear. <a href="Blackhawk">Blackhawk</a> "Serpa" shoulder holsters and cross-draw type holsters are not authorized. Tactical "drop down" holsters /thigh rigs will not be used unless that equipment is worn in the normal course of their duties and authorized by their unit policy. <a href="Additional equipment such as tourniquets">Additional equipment such as tourniquets</a>, etc., shall not be attached to duty holsters.

## <u>Personnel not in compliance with the above directions will be required to correct equipment deficiencies and re-schedule the shoot at a later date.</u>
