Portions of this document are deemed by the San Diego Police Department to be records of security procedures and are exempt from disclosure under the California Public Records Act (CPRA), Government Code Section 6254 (f).

The Mandatory Handgun Training Shoot will begin February 22, 2022 and conclude May 13, 2022. The shoot will include the annual Shotgun Qualification. All sworn officers and civilians authorized to carry firearms on duty are required to attend. Dates available for the shoot will be posted on the Department's Success Factors training site entitled "*Firearms Training Shoot - Spring*." Immediate supervisors will ensure their personnel are scheduled for the Department Shoot and track their attendance.

The Handgun Training Shoot will consist of accuracy and performance drills up to 50 yards from the target. Sworn personnel must bring their primary, Department-approved duty handgun with **a minimum of three magazines**. The Firearms Training Unit will provide training ammunition for the shoot. Personnel must arrive fifteen minutes prior to the scheduled training time for loading of training ammunition, a weapon inspection for authorized accessories, and any necessary adjustments. **Personnel who arrive late will be turned away and directed to reschedule the training.**

Supervisors and officers working patrol and other uniformed assignments must wear their full duty equipment. Supervisors and officers working investigations and non-uniformed assignments are expected to shoot with the holster that is worn in everyday use; non-uniformed assignments may NOT use patrol style leather gear. **Blackhawk "Serpa", (or other holsters with unlocking mechanisms manipulated by the shooter's trigger-finger), shoulder holsters and cross-draw type holsters are not authorized. Additional equipment such as tourniquets, etc., shall not be attached to duty holsters.** Tactical "drop down" holsters /thigh rigs **will not** be used unless that equipment is worn in the normal course of their duties and authorized by their unit policy.

Personnel not in compliance with the above directions will be required to correct equipment deficiencies and re-schedule the shoot at a later date.

Personnel authorized to carry a shotgun will qualify with the shotgun after the handgun shoot. **Personnel with a Department-issued shotgun, or a personally owned shotgun carried on duty, must bring that shotgun for inspection and qualification. For the shotgun qualification, bring all of your issued ammunition and a sleeve for spare ammunition if you have one.** Duty ammunition will be used for the shotgun qualification and personnel will receive new duty ammunition after the shoot.
