From **Monday, July 18, 2022, through Thursday, August 18, 2022**, the Leadership Development Unit (LDU) will be conducting mandatory update training for all captains, lieutenants, and sergeants. Acting sergeants may also attend at the discretion of their commanding officer and dependent on available space. The training will provide information and skills that are current and relevant to the duties and responsibilities of captains, lieutenants, and sergeants.

The training sessions are two days in length. There will be two session per week for five weeks. Subjects such as: IA updates, POBAR, discipline processing, Homicide updates, Crime Lab processing, RAP/RIU, search and seizures, and new QMR preview will be presented. Also, mandatory AB 2504 training and Active Shooter/Rescue Task Force (RTF)/ICS refresher training will be included.

All training will be held in the auditorium located at Police Plaza, 4020 Murphy Canyon Rd., San Diego, CA. 92123. All attendees are encouraged to bring note-taking material.

All captains, lieutenants and sergeants shall attend their following listed sessions for their unit (shown below). If you cannot attend your listed session, you may attend an alternate session with approval from your Commanding Officer and the LDU.

All personnel must register via SuccessFactors for participants to receive credit for the training. The sessions are already posted online (If your current assignment does not fall into one of the listed commands, please attend one of the three last sessions). **Register by July 15, 2022**.

The use of overtime or adjusting shift for attending personnel is each individual command's discretion.

The command training schedule is as follows:
