Labor Day marks the end of the busy summer season at our local beaches. It is however, one of the busiest holidays of the summer. To provide the maximum level of staffing for our beaches and neighborhoods, the Department will be moving to a mandatory 12 on 12 off schedule starting Saturday September 3, 2022 at **(Deleted – records of security)** hours and ending Tuesday September 6, 2022 at **(Deleted – records of security)** hours.

The mandatory 12-hour shifts will include all Patrol Operations, Traffic Motors and CIB, as well as the Neighborhood Policing Division. Shift hours will be as follows:

- Officers working first watch will work **(Deleted – records of security)** hours.
- Officers working second watch will work **(Deleted – records of security)** hours.
- Officers working third watch will work **(Deleted – records of security)** hours.

All second watch personnel will be assigned to Beach Command at Northern or Western Division. More information will be forthcoming on where you are scheduled for the shift, who you are working for, and the equipment you will need to bring.

All personnel on days off are encouraged to work one of the approved overtime assignments that are available. Sergeants are eligible to work POII positions. Filling these positions will lessen the burden on Beach Command as well as overall patrol operations. Contact CRO **(Deleted – records of security)** for overtime at Northern Division. Contact Sergeant **(Deleted – records of security)** for overtime at Western Division.

Safety is our highest priority. 12-hour shifts enable the Department to provide the highest level of officer safety and the highest level of public safety for this busy holiday weekend. Thank you in advance for your service, teamwork, and dedication.
