Effective February 7, 2023, the new cycle of Advanced Officer Training (A.O.T.) 2023-2024 will begin. The training classes will run until the end of 2024. All sworn personnel from the rank of Sergeant and below **shall** attend A.O.T. during the training cycle. This training course will be four days (Tuesday-Friday). You must be full duty to attend A.O.T.

P.O.S.T. requires that <u>all</u> sworn officers must complete this training every two years. A.O.T. satisfies the P.O.S.T. requirements for Sergeant and below and will keep officers in compliance. All sworn personnel from the rank of Lieutenant and above shall attend a minimum of 24 hours of a P.O.S.T. approved course or complete a minimum of 24 hours of POST approved on-line training to meet their compliance requirement within this two-year training cycle.

<u>Enrollment in A.O.T. will be assigned by In-Service Training to ensure everyone</u> completes their training on time without interfering with their CPR/First Aid certification.

Personnel will be assigned to attend at approximately the same time as in the previous cycle. An email will be sent in advance by (**Deleted – records of security**). If there is a conflict with training dates, please contact (**Deleted – records of security**) via email at (**Deleted – records of security**) as soon as possible to reschedule.

Once an AOT date is received, it is your responsibility to advise your command and have the dates entered and approved in the Redbook as soon as possible to avoid staffing issues.

Failure to attend A.O.T or complete C.P.T. during the 2023-2024 training cycle will result in non-compliance with P.O.S.T. mandated training and could result in

disciplinary action by the Department.
