- I. <u>Call to Order</u> Commissioner Vernon Franck called the City of San Diego (City) Commission for Arts and Culture's Executive Committee to order at 9:55 a.m. at the City Council Committee Room, 12th Floor, City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California 92101.
- II. Non-agenda Public Comment
 - Peter Comiskey (Balboa Park Cultural Partnership) commented on FY19 departmental budget distribution.
- III. <u>Chair's Reports</u>
 - A. ACTION February 9, 2018 Executive Committee Meeting Minutes Commissioner Vernon Franck initiated discussion on this item. Commissioner Bossler referenced a discussion had at the Policy and Funding Committee meeting on March 9, 2018 regarding minutes and requested that discussion apply to Executive Committee minutes as well. Commissioner Tyler Hewes made a motion to approve the Executive Committee meeting minutes of February 9, 2018. Commissioner Ben Meza seconded the motion. The vote was 5-0-1; the motion passed.

B. <u>Commission Business</u> – Commissioner Vernon Franck announced that City Council ratified the Mayor's appointments of Udoka Nwanna, Julie Z. Cramer and Roberta Alexander to the Commission on February 26, 2018 as well as reappointments of Michael Brown, Gina Jackson, Vernon Franck, and Benjamin Meza.

- C. <u>Update on Committee Member Appointments</u> Commissioner Vernon Franck shared that Commission Chair Janet Poutré is in the process of determining her proposed appointments of new Commissioners to committees and that the roster would be published with the Commission packet 72 hours in advance of the Commission meeting.
- D. <u>Update on FY18 Arts Education Enrichment Initiative</u> Commissioner Vernon Franck shared that the evaluation of applications for the FY18 Arts Education Enrichment Initiative is in progress and that funding recommendations would be published with the Commission packet 72 hours in advance of the Commission meeting.

IV. <u>Committee Reports</u> –

- A. Policy & Funding Commissioner Jason Whooper, Chair of the Policy & Funding Committee, reported that the committee recently discussed FY19 departmental budget distribution priorities and decided to postpone action on the item until the next committee meeting, after receiving additional departmental budget information to help them in making recommendations on budget distribution priorities.
- B. Public Art Commissioner Vernon Franck, Chair of the Public Art Committee, reported that there will be two public art-related action items on the agenda for the March 23rd Commission meeting.
- C. Advocacy & Outreach Commissioner Tyler Hewes, Chair of the Advocacy & Outreach Committee, reported that the committee did not meet due to lack of quorum. Committee is working on identifying third-party validators and will be requesting assistance from Commission staff to schedule meetings with City Councilmembers and Mayor.
- D. Commissioner Engagement Commissioner Ann Bossler, Chair of the Commissioner Engagement Ad Hoc Committee, reported that the final version of the charter for the ad hoc committee will be provided by staff. Commissioner Bossler inquired about holding the Commissioner Engagement Ad Hoc Committee meeting offsite and was informed that meetings of the Commission's committees are typically held at the office of the Commission for Arts and Culture or City Council Committee Room, depending on what's available and due in part to staff shortage. Chief of Civic Art Strategies Christine Jones mentioned that the April Commission meeting would be held offsite.
- V. <u>ACTION March 23, 2018 Regular Commission Meeting Agenda</u> Commissioner Vernon Franck initiated discussion on this item. Commissioner Vernon Franck motioned to approve the March 23, 2018 regular Commission meeting agenda with the following edits:
 - 1. Change FY19 budget distribution priorities from an action item to a presentation and discussion item.
 - 2. Add a status report on the Executive Director search under Executive Director's Report.
 - 3. Add a status report on Commission staffing under Executive Director's Report.
