- I. <u>Call to Order</u> Commissioner Jason Whooper called the City of San Diego (City) Commission for Arts and Culture's Policy & Funding Committee to order at 8:05 a.m. at the City Council Committee Room, 12th Floor, City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California 92101.
- II. Non-agenda Public Comment
 - Peter Comiskey (Balboa Park Cultural Partnership) commented on external trustees.
- III. <u>Chair's Reports</u> Commissioner Jason Whooper asked Commissioners to make any necessary conflict of interest disclosures. Commissioner Vernon Franck disclosed that he is an unpaid board member of A Ship in the Woods Foundation.
 - A. ACTION February 09, 2018 Meeting Minutes Commissioner Jason Whooper initiated discussion on this item. Commissioner Bossler and Commissioner Franck expressed concern that important points of discussions during meetings were not being captured in minutes and requested that minutes in general include key points and important topics of discussion. Chief of Civic Art Strategies Christine E. Jones shared that staff would review information being included and that if there were any points that Commissioners would like to see reflected in the minutes, those additions could be requested as part of the motion. Commissioner Vernon Franck made a motion to approve the Policy & Funding Committee meeting minutes of February 09, 2018. Commissioner Ann Bossler seconded the motion. Commissioner Ann Bossler made an amendment to the original motion to request that staff include the following four (4) items: edits to the minutes: 1) Add that Commissioners are willing and desire to participate in any way that is helpful in the Executive Director search; 2) Add that Commissioners expressed concern about the short timeframe for FY18 Arts Education Enrichment initiative to have the desired impact; 3) Add that Commissioners provided feedback on FY19 applicants and communications to them about Option to Extend. 4) Commissioner Ann Bossler also requested the inclusion of discussion items from the agenda beyond action items. Commissioner Vernon Franck seconded the amendment to the original motion. The vote was 3-0-0; the amendment to the original motion passed.

Cramer and Roberta Alexander to the Commission on February 26, 2018 as well as reappointments of Michael Brown, Gina Jackson, Vernon Franck, and Benjamin Meza; and commented on the presence and purpose of the 2018 committee work plan.

- IV. ACTION FY19 Departmental Budget Distribution Priorities Commissioner Jason Whooper initiated discussion on this item. Acting Executive Director Darrin Schwabe presented the staff recommendation for departmental budget distribution priorities. Discussion topics included the use of percentages to determine distribution priorities, budget season timeline and the desire on the part of Commissioners for more departmental budget information to help them in making recommendations on budget distribution priorities. Commissioner Ann Bossler and Commissioner Vernon Franck requested a breakdown of the budget vs. actuals for the past two fiscal years; information related to the City's contractual obligation to Horton Plaza Theatre Foundation; and information about the proposed 2% cut to the department budget that was previously submitted to the Mayor. Commissioner Ann Bossler requested that clarity on the proposed 2% cut to the department budget be either provided in person or via an official letterhead from Kris Michell. Action was postponed to the next Policy & Funding Committee Meeting.




Commission's Role

With regards to other budget related roles for the Commission, pursuant to the San Diego Municipal Code 26.0704, the Commission:

- j) Recommends to the Mayor and City Council the fair distribution of TOT funds to nonprofit arts and culture organizations to support local arts and culture programming
- c) Evaluates the City's allocation of Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) funds for arts and culture and strongly advocates for increasing arts and culture funding to levels which measurably support the vitality and stability of established arts and culture organizations and which foster an environment attractive to and nurturing of emerging arts and culture organizations

So what does this mean?

- 1) Review and ratify panel ranks for Arts & Culture funding programs
- 2) Recommend award amounts for Arts & Culture funding programs
- 3) Strongly advocate for more funding

Budget Priorities for Art & Culture

Last Year's Budget Priorities Recommended by Commission

- Fund OSP at 73% of total department budget, including a distribution to Horton Plaza Theatre Foundation/RDA Obligation at \$435,000
- 2. Fund CCSD at 8% of total department budget
- 3. Fund Collections Management at 3% of total department budget
- 4. Fund Commission-Initiated Public Art Projects at 2% of total dept. budget
- 5. Fund the Mayor/City Council Allocation at \$400,000
- 6. Fund Arts Ed Enrichment at 2% of total department budget

All numbers are approximate and based on final budget distribution recommendation ratified by Commission on June 23, 2017.






STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Recommend that the City of San Diego Commission for Arts and Culture (Commission) recommend to the City of San Diego Mayor and City Council the Request for Proposal ranks for FY19 Organizational Support Program and Creative Community San Diego funding categories, as submitted by Commission Advisory Panelists.

SUMMARY

The City of San Diego (City) issued the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for FY19 Organizational Support Program (OSP) and Creative Communities San Diego (CCSD) funding categories on October 31, 2017. One hundred fifty-five (155) nonprofit organizations submitted an application in response to the RFQ. Of those applicants, one hundred forty-nine (149) were scored as qualified and asked to submit a proposal in response to the Request for Proposal (RFP). All qualified first-time applicants were required to submit a proposal; qualified applicants under contract with the City for FY18 OSP and CCSD funding, were able to select between submitting a proposal and requesting that the City exercise the Option to Renew their FY18 agreement. In total, fifty-five (55) proposals were submitted in response to the RFP and ninety-three (93) requests to exercise the Option to Renew were received. Organizations who were granted the Option to Renew agreed to retain their ratified rank from FY18.

In December 2017, the Commission appointed Commission Advisory Panels (CAP) to participate in the review of proposals received by the City for the FY19 OSP and CCSD funding categories. Over a two week period, CAPs convened in five separate public meetings; each panel evaluated a specific group of proposals using standard criteria and scoring. The panels also included a pilot process allowing applicants to address the panel at two prescribed intervals – prior to and following the panel discussion of each applicant's proposal. After evaluation of all proposals and scoring, each CAP voted to recommend ranks for their specific group of proposals. The lists included with this report show all qualified applicants, including the recommended ranks provided by the FY19 CAPs and ranks retained by applicants who were granted the Option to Renew.

NEXT STEPS

Following Policy & Funding Committee's recommendation, the Commission will receive and vote to recommend the RFP ranks to the Mayor and City Council. Commission staff will use the recommended rank as one factor in the calculation of each applicant's contract award amount, using the standard award algorithm as stated in the FY19 OSP Funding Guidelines and FY19 CCSD Funding Guidelines. Tentative award amounts will be shared with applicants as they are available, and final award amounts will be announced by June 29, 2018.
