

# Sample Ballot, General Election, April 6, 1915

## INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS:

To vote for a candidate of your selection, stamp a cross (X) in the voting square to the right of the name of such candidate. Where two or more candidates for the same office are to be elected, stamp a cross (X) after the names of all of the candidates for that office for whom you desire to vote, not to exceed, however, the number of candidates who are to be elected. To vote for a person not on the ballot write the name of such person under the title of the office in the blank space left for that purpose. If you desire to ratify any ordinance contained herein, stamp a cross (X) in the voting square at the right of and opposite the words "For the Ordinance, etc." If you desire not to ratify any ordinance contained herein, stamp a cross (X) in the voting square at the right of and opposite the words "Against the Ordinance, etc." All marks except the cross (X) are forbidden. All distinguishing marks or erasures are forbidden and make the ballot void. If you wrongly stamp, tear or deface this ballot return it to the inspector of the election and obtain another.
