Special Election, Nov. 27, 1917

Instructions to Voters:

If you desire to ratify the ordinance contained herein stamp a cross (X) in the voting square at the right of and opposite the words "For the ordinance, etc." If you desire not to ratify the ordinance contained herein, stamp a cross (X) in the voting square at the right of and opposite the words "Against the ordinance, etc." All marks except the cross (X) are forbidden. All distinguishing marks or erasures are forbidden and make the ballot void. If you wrongly stamp, tear or deface this ballot return it to the inspector of the election and obtain another.

PROPOSITION TO BE VOTED UPON

FOR THE ORDINANCE defining alcoholic liquor to be any compound containing more than one-half of one per cent. by volume of alcohol not so mixed with other drugs as to prevent its use as a beverage; making it unlawful and punishable by fine and imprisonment to manufacture, sell, barter, offer for sale, give away, have, keep, solicit orders for, take orders for, furnish, deliver, serve, distribute, ship into, bring into, or receive within the city any such alcoholic liquor, or to establish, maintain, conduct, operate or receive the profits from any place where any such alcoholic liquor is manufactured, received, kept, sold, served, offered for sale, furnished, or distributed, sales by licensed pharmacists for sacramental, medicinal, scientific or mechanical purposes excepted; providing that all places where liquor is kept in violation of the ordinance are public nuisances and as such shall be abated; making it the duty of the chief of police to put under police surveillance any person suspected of violating the provisions of the ordinance, and conferring upon proper authorities the right to enter and search any place where liquor is kept in violation of the terms of the ordinance, and to seize such liquors.
