If you desire not to ratify the proposition contained herein for the amendment of the Charter of The City of San Diego, stamp a cross (X) in the voting square at the right of and opposite the word "No," which is in the square at the right of such proposition. To vote for the proposition relative to discontinuance in use as a public park a portion of Balboa Park and devote same to municipal use as a site for the erection of public buildings, etc., stamp a cross (X) in the voting square at the right of the word "Yes."
