ORDINANCE NO. 11785

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$300.00 FROM THE WATER DEPRECIATION FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF RE-NEWING SERVICES IN ALLEY IN BLOCK 76 OF THE AMENDED MAP OF CITY HEIGHTS.

BE IT ORDAINED, By the Common Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be, and the same is hereby set aside and appropriated out of the Water Depreciation Fund of said City for the purpose, only and exclusively, of renewing depreciated water services in the Alley in Block 76, of Amended Map of City Heights, in the City of San Diego.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirty-first day from and after its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 11786

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY KNOWN AS LA MESA COLONY NO. 2 TO THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA.

WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of April, 1928, a petition was filed with the Common Council of The City of San Diego, asking that said The City of San Diego annex to said City certain territory described in said petition, and designated as La Mesa Colony No. 2; and

WHEREAS, said petition contained the names of one-fourth of the qualified electors residing within the territory described in said petition, as shown by the registration of voters of the County of San Diego, in which said territory is situate, as required by Section 2 of the Annexation Act of 1913; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms and provisions of said Annexation Act of 1913, the Common Council at a regular meeting held April 9th, 1928, adopted Ordinance No. 11672, entitled, "An Ordinance calling a special election for the submission of a proposition to annex to The City of San Diego certain additional territory designated as La Mesa Colony No. 2 to the qualified electors residing there," which said ordinance was approved by the Mayor of said City on April 9th, 1928, wherein and whereby a Special Election was called in the territory described in said petition, to be held in said territory on the 12th day of June, 1928, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said territory a proposition to annex to, incorporate in and make a part of The City of San Diego said territory described in said petition; and

WHEREAS, a Special Election was held in said territory on the 12th day of June, A. D. 1928, pursuant to the provisions of said Ordinance No. 11672, and of the terms and provisions of said Annexation Act of 1913; and

WHEREAS, at said Special Election there was submitted to the qualified electors residing in said territory the following proposition:

PROPOSITION.

Shall the territory herein designated as La Mesa Colony No. 2, and particularly described as follows: All that portion of the County of San Diego, State of California, embraced within the following described boundaries, to-wit:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 32 of La Mesa Colony, according to Map thereof No. 346, on file in the office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, California, said corner being on the easterly boundary line of The City of San Diego; thence southerly along the said easterly boundary of The City of San Diego to the most northerly corner of Lot 29, of Metropolitan Center, according to Map thereof No. 2085, on file in the office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, California; thence in a southeasterly direction along the easterly line of said Metropolitan Center to the most easterly corner of Lot 28 of said Metropolitan Center; thence south 46° 20' east along the southeasterly production of the easterly line of said Metropolitan Center a distance of 31.41 feet to a point; thence north 86° 35' east a distance of 310.54 feet to a point; thence north 1° 22' east, a distance of 75.03 feet to a point; thence south 88° 34' east to a point on the westerly line of Cajon Avenue; thence in a southwesterly and westerly direction along the northwesterly and northerly line of said Cajon Avenue to an intersection with the northerly production of the easterly line of Lot 16, Block 3, of Rolando Unit No. 1, according to Map No. 1932, on file in the office of the County Recorder of San Diego County, California; thence southwesterly in a direct line to the northeasterly corner of said Lot 16, Block 3, of Rolando Unit No. 1, which corner is in the southerly line of Cajon Avenue; thence easterly and northeasterly along the southerly and southeasterly lines of said Cajon Avenue and its northeasterly production to an intersection with the southerly line of Ramona Street; thence easterly along the southerly line of Ramona

Street to an intersection with the northerly production of the westerly line of Lot J of said La Mesa Colony; thence southerly along the northerly production of the westerly line of said Lot J, and the westerly line of said Lot J to the southwest corner of said Lot J; thence easterly along the southerly line of said La Mesa Colony to a point distant 300 feet westerly from the easterly line of Lot L of said La Mesa Colony; thence northerly along a line parallel to and distant 300 feet westerly from the easterly line of said Lot L to an intersection with the northerly line of said Lot L; thence northerly in a direct line to a point on the southerly line of Lot 17, Block 9, said La Mesa Colony, distant 20 feet easterly from the southwest corner of said Lot 17; thence northerly along a line parallel to and distant 20 feet easterly from the westerly line of said Lot 17 of block 9 to an intersection with the northerly line of said Lot 17; thence westerly along the northerly line of said Lot 17 to the northwesterly corner of said Lot 17; thence northerly in a direct line to the southeasterly corner of Lot 7 of Block 9 of said La Mesa Colony; thence northerly along the easterly line of said Lot 7 of said Block 9 to the southerly line of Cajon Street; thence easterly along the southerly line of Cajon Street to an intersection with the westerly line of Helen Street; thence southerly along the westerly line of Helen Street and its southerly production to an intersection with the southerly line of Ramona Street; thence easterly along the southerly line of Ramona Street to an intersection with the southerly production of the easterly line of Dora Street; thence northerly along the southerly production of the easterly line of Dora Street and along the easterly line of Dora Street to an intersection with the easterly prolongation of the southerly line of the alley in Block 15 of said La Mesa Colony; thence westerly along the easterly prolongation of the southerly line of the alley in said Block 15, along the southerly line of the alley in said block 15, and along the westerly prolongation of the southerly line of the alley in said Block 15, to an intersection with the easterly line of Helen Street; thence northerly along the easterly line of Helen Street to an intersection with the northerly line of Cajon Street; thence westerly along the northerly line of Cajon Street to an intersection with the easterly line of Lois Street; thence northerly along the easterly line of Lois Street to an intersection with the easterly prolongation of the southerly line of the alley in Block 8 of said La Mesa Colony; thence westerly along the easterly prolongation of the southerly line of the alley in said Block 8, along the southerly line of the alley in said Block 8, and along the westerly prolongation of the southerly line of the alley in said Block 8 to an intersection with the easterly line of Victoria Street; thence northerly along the easterly line of Victoria Street to an intersection with the northerly line of Santiago Street; thence westerly along the northerly line of Santiago Street to an intersection with the westerly line of Olive Street; thence southerly along the westerly line of Olive Street to an intersection with the southerly line of Cajon Street; thence easterly along the southerly line of Cajon Street to the northeast corner of Lot 8 of Block 6 of said La Mesa Colony; thence southerly along the easterly line of said Lot 8 and its southerly prolongation to an intersection with the southerly line of the alley in said Block 6 of La Mesa Colony; thence westerly along the southerly line of the alley in said Block 6 of La Mesa Colony and its westerly prolongation to an intersection with the easterly line of Olive Street; thence westerly in a direct line to the point of intersection of the easterly prolongation of the southerly line of the Alley in Block 3 of said La Mesa Colony with the westerly line of Olive Street; thence westerly along the easterly prolongation of the southerly line of the alley in said Block 3 and along the southerly line of the alley in said Block 3 to the northeast corner of Lot 21 of said Block 3; thence northerly in a direct line to the southeast corner of Lot 4 of said Block 3; thence northerly along the easterly line of said Lot 4 to the southerly line of Cajon Street; thence northerly in a direct line to the southeast corner of Lot 21 of Block 2 of said La Mesa Colony; thence westerly along the southerly line of said Block 2 of La Mesa Colony, and along the westerly prolongation of the southerly line of said Block 2, to an intersection with the westerly line of Alice Street; thence southerly along the westerly line of Alice Street to an intersection with the original center line of Cajon Avenue (now closed to public use), as said Cajon Avenue is shown on said Map No. 346 of said La Mesa Colony; thence westerly along the original center line of said Cajon Avenue (now closed to public use), to an intersection with the southerly prolongation of the line between Lots 33 and 32 of said La Mesa Colony; thence northerly along the southerly prolongation of the line between said Lots 33 and 32, and along the line between said Lots 33 and 32 to the northeast corner of said Lot 33; thence westerly along the line between said Lots 33 and 32 of said La Mesa Colony, to the point of beginning; be annexed to The City of San Diego?

The property above described after such annexation to be subject to taxation equally with the property within The City of San Diego, to pay the following outstanding bonded indebtedness of The City of San Diego, to-wit:

A bond issue of \$65,000.00 bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum, issued by the Common Council of The City of San Diego, for the purpose of refunding the indebtedness of said City in the sum of \$260,000.00, as evidenced by certain municipal bonds for sewer construction, said issue being authorized by Ordinance No. 483 of the ordinances of said City, passed and adopted by the Common Council of said City December 20, 1897, and approved by the Mayor thereof December 21, 1897, in pursuance of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California; approved March 9, 1897, entitled, "An Act authorizing the Common Council, board of trustees, or other governing body of any incorporated city or town other than cities of the first class, to refund its indebtedness, to issue bonds therefor, and to provide for the payment of the same." That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$65,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$600,000.00 bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum, for the acquisition of a water supply, rights of way, water works, pumps, reservoirs, etc. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$209,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$37,000.00 for acquiring land and constructing buildings for the Fire Department, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$13,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$140,000.00 for sewer improvements, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$56,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$199,000.00 for water works improvements, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$79,600.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$75,000.00 for construction and completion of the B Street Conduit, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$33,750.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$54,000.00 for the replacement of the water main in 30th Street, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$24,300.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$59,108.55 for the construction of a water main from 5th Street and University Avenue to the Old Town Reservoir, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$29,108.55

A bonded indebtedness of \$265,891.45 for the general enlargement and extension of the water system of The City of San Diego, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$125,891.45

A bonded indebtedness of \$151,933.71, for the construction of certain reservoirs and the repair of other reservoirs, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$71,933.71

A bonded indebtedness of \$70,000.00 for the construction of certain boulevards and roads in said City, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$30,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$50,000.00 for the construction of seven reinforced concrete culverts, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$20,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$65,000.00 for the construction of buildings and the completion of other buildings for the Fire Department of The City of San Diego, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$25,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$52,894.54 for the enlargement and extension of the main sewer system of The City of San Diego, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$22,894.54

A bonded indebtedness of \$12,834.58 for the construction of sewers in Florence Heights, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$2,834.58

A bonded indebtedness of \$34,112.00 for the La Jolla Sewer system, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$14,112.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$340,000.00 for the construction of additions to the water system of The City of San Diego, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$187,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$92,500.00 for the extension and addition to the City's sewer system north of Upas Street and east of Indiana Street, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$50,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$26,000.00 for the extension and addition to the City's sewer system north of Juniper Street to University Avenue and east of the City Park; bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$14,950.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$74,500.00 for the extension and addition of the City's sewer system in portions of Arnold & Choate's Addition, Mission Hills; Horoton's Addition, Palm Heights, Idylwild, Middletown, Middletown Addition, and other adjacent territory, and a gravity line of sewers to carry the sewage handled by the ejector at Fifth Street and University Avenue; bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$40,500.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$1,000,000.00 for the improvement of the 1400 acre Public Park, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$575,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$1,000,000.00 for a municipal wharf, and other harbor improvements, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$600,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$80,000.00 for the extension of the fire system of the City, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$48,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$120,000.00 for the extension of the sewer system of the City, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$72,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$54,000.00 for the improvement of various street and highways in The City of San Diego, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$32,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$340,000.00 for the extension of the water system of the City, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$204,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$75,000.00 for the acquisition and equipment of public playgrounds in said City, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$45,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$10,000.00 for the construction of a public comfort station bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$2,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$2,500,000.00 for the acquisition of water works and water rights, including lands, dams, damsites, reservoirs, reservoir sites, rights of ways, pipe lines, conduits and water filtering plant for the use of said City, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$1,552,500.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$275,000.00 for the improvement of the water system of The City of San Diego, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$178,750.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$850,000.00 for the improvement of Balboa Park, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$552,500.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$705,000.00 for the improvement of the water system of The City of San Diego, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$475,875.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$1,500,000.00 for the acquisition of water works and water rights, including lands, dam, dam site, reservoir, reservoir site and rights of way, and the right to use wagon roads, telephone lines and other property rights in connection with said water works and property, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$1,012,500.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$400,000.00 for additional harbor improvements in said City, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$270,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$100,000.00 for the acquisition, construction and completion of the Dulzura Conduit, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$72,500.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$682,200.00 for the acquisition, construction and completion of the Lower Otay Dam, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$507,200.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$1,000,000.00 for the acquisition, construction and completion of a masonry dam at the Barrett Dam Site, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$800,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$200,000.00 for the acquisition, construction, and completion of improvements and extensions to the San Diego-Otay wood-stave pipe line, and for the acquisition, construction and completion of extensions and additions to the water distributing system within the City, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of

said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$160,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$80,000.00 for the improvement of Tide Street in said City, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$64,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$250,000.00 for the acquisition, construction and completion of a reinforced concrete bulkhead for a solid fill pier in the Bay of San Diego north of the Municipal Pier, and for dredging on either side and at the end of said bulkhead; bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$201,250.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$500,000.00 for the completion of Barrett Dam, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$425,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$70,000.00 for the improvement of Imperial Avenue, between 32nd Street and 40th Street, and of 40th Street, from Imperial Avenue to the County Highway, and of Imperial Avenue, through Encanto; bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$50,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$30,000.00 for the improvement of Balboa Park Boulevard, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$18,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$325,000.00 for the construction of additions to the water distributing system, and the construction of a steel stand pipe in The City of San Diego, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$289,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$495,500.00 for the construction of Municipal Pier No. 2, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$445,500.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$400,000.00 for the acquisition of a second main water conduit from the Lower Otay Reservoir to the Bonita Wye, in the County of San Diego, State of California, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$360,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$250,000.00 for the acquisition, construction, and completion of certain municipal improvements in the Bay of San Diego, which improvements consist of the dredging out of the bottom of the Bay of San Diego between the foot of Columbia Street and a point approximately the foot of Eighth Street, together with the construction of a bulkhead, and the filling of the tide lands back of said bulkhead, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$226,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$225,000.00 for the improvement and completion of Municipal Pier No. 2, in the Bay of San Diego, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$207,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$4,500,000.00 for the acquisition of lands, dam site, reservoir, reservoir site, rights of way, pipe lines, conduits and water filtering plant for a dam, and the acquisition, construction and completion of a dam at El Capitan Dam Site No. 2, on the San Diego River, in the County of San Diego, bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$4,162,500.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$100,000.00 for the construction of a trunk line sewer in East San Diego, in The City of San Diego, bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$85,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$500,000.00 for the acquisition of an option to purchase the San Dieguito Water System, located in the County of San Diego, State of California, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$450,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$2,000,000.00 for the acquisition, construction and completion of two masonry dams, one at the Sutherland Damsite on the Santa Ysabel Creek, in the County of San Diego, State of California, and the other at the San Vicente Damsite, on the San Vicente Creek, a tributary of the San Diego River, in said County and State, together with the acquisition of lands, reservoirs, reservoir sites, water rights, water-bearing lands, rights of way, and water pumping plants for dams and reservoirs, and the acquisition, construction and completion of pipe lines and conduits connecting said Sutherland Dam and Reservoir with the San Vicente Dam and Reservoir, and a pipe line and conduit from said San Vicente Reservoir to a connection with the City's distributing water mains to be located at Lakeside, in said County and State, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/2% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$1,950,000.00

A bonded indebtedness of \$650,000.00 for the acquisition, construction and completion of a Municipal Air Port, bearing interest at the rate of 4-1/4% per annum. That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$650,000.00

That the total amount of the bonded indebtedness authorized and incurred by said The City of San Diego is \$23,926,474.83.

That the total amount of said bonded indebtedness outstanding at this date is \$17,857,949.83.

AND WHEREAS, the election board appointed in said Ordinance No. 11672 made due return of said election to the City Clerk of said City of San Diego and to the Common Council of said City, all as required by law; and

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of June, 1928, at a regular meeting next after the expiration of three days from and after the date of said election, the Common Council publicly opened and canvassed the returns of said election, and thereupon caused a record thereof to be made and entered upon its minutes stating the proposition submitted and showing the whole number of votes cast thereon in the territory proposed to be annexed, the number of votes cast therein in favor of annexation, and the number of votes cast therein against the annexation, and by said canvass said Common Council ascertained and determined that a majority of all the votes cast in such outside territory on the question of such annexation was in favor of annexation, whereupon said Common Council duly and regularly adopted Resolution No. 46055, which said resolution declared the result of said Special Election so held on the 12th day of June A. D. 1928; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council by said canvass and in said resolution declared the result of said election to be as follows:

The whole number of votes cast in said territory on said proposition was Thirty (30).

That on the proposition set out on the ballot as follows:

"Shall La Mesa Colony No. 2 be annexed to The City of San Diego, and the property therein be, after such annexation, subject to taxation equally with the property within said City, to pay the following outstanding bonded indebtedness:

BE IT ORDAINED By the Common Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the annexation of the following described territory situated in the County of San Diego, State of California, to-wit:

alley in said block 15, to an intersection with the easterly line of Helen Street; thence northerly along the easterly line of Helen Street to an intersection with the northerly line of Cajon Street; thence westerly along the northerly line of Cajon Street to an intersection with the easterly line of Lois Street; thence northerly along the easterly line of Lois Street to an intersection with the easterly prolongation of the southerly line of the alley in Block 8 of said La Mesa Colony; thence westerly along the easterly prolongation of the southerly line of the alley in said Block 8, along the southerly line of the alley in said Block 8, and along the westerly prolongation of the southerly line of the alley in said Block 8 to an intersection with the easterly line of Victoria Street; thence northerly along the easterly line of Victoria Street to an intersection with the northerly line of Santiago Street; thence westerly along the northerly line of Santiago Street to an intersection with the westerly line of Olive Street; thence southerly along the westerly line of Olive Street to an intersection with the southerly line of Cajon Street; thence easterly along the southerly line of Cajon Street to the northeast corner of Lot 8 of Block 6 of said La Mesa Colony; thence southerly along the easterly line of said Lot 8 and its southerly prolongation to an intersection with the southerly line of the alley in said Block 6 of La Mesa Colony; thence westerly along the southerly line of the alley in said Block 6 of La Mesa Colony and its westerly prolongation to an intersection with the easterly line of Olive Street; thence westerly in a direct line to the point of intersection of the easterly prolongation of the southerly line of the Alley in Block 3 of said La Mesa Colony with the westerly line of Olive Street; thence westerly along the easterly prolongation of the southerly line of the alley in said Block 3 and along the southerly line of the alley in said Block 3 to the northeast corner of Lot 21 of said Block 3; thence northerly in a direct line to the southeast corner of Lot 4 of said Block 3; thence northerly along the easterly line of said Lot 4 to the southerly line of Cajon Street; thence northerly in a direct line to the southeast corner of Lot 21 of Block 2 of said La Mesa Colony; thence westerly along the southerly line of said Block 2 of La Mesa Colony, and along the westerly prolongation of the southerly line of said Block 2, to an intersection with the westerly line of Alice Street; thence southerly along the westerly line of Alice Street to an intersection with the original center line of Cajon Avenue (now closed to public use), as said Cajon Avenue is shown on said Map No. 346 of said La Mesa Colony; thence westerly along the original center line of said Cajon Avenue (now closed to public use), to an intersection with the southerly prolongation of the line between Lots 33 and 32 of said La Mesa Colony; thence northerly along the southerly prolongation of the line between said Lots 33 and 32, and along the line between said Lots 33 and 32 to the northeast corner of said Lot 33; thence westerly along the line between said Lots 33 and 32 of said La Mesa Colony, to the point of beginning; to The City of San Diego, as authorized and approved by the electors residing within said territory at the Special Election held on June 12th, 1928, be, and the same is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Clerk of said City be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of California; and from and after the date of the filing in the office of the Secretary of State of California, of a certified copy of this ordinance, the territory hereinabove in Section One described shall be to all intents and purposes a part of The City of San Diego, and the property within such annexed territory shall be taxed to pay the bonded indebtedness of The City of San Diego equally with the property within such City as it existed at the date of such annexation.

Section 3. That the City Clerk of said City be, and he is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in the official newspaper of said City, to-wit, The Evening Tribune.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirty-first day from and after its passage and approval.
