3. **Paradise Hills/Skyline Planning Committee** – John Mooney reported, the capital improvement list is going to be modified to reflect the need for the hiking/walking trail at the Paradise Hills Community Park.
4. **Paradise Hills Native Garden** – Nancy Janssen reported, the Native Garden were informed by Council District 4 regarding support for the hiking trail to coincide with the general development plan for the Paradise Hills Community Park.

PARKS AND RECREATION STAFF REPORTS

1. **Ron Agustin, Area Manager II**– Elleese Fillmore is covering Bay Terraces while Kemii is on maternity leave. The Penn Athletic Field was renovated during the summer and reopened on September 26th. Penn Athletic Field is on a new watering schedule. Currently 2 maintenance staff vacancies. The department will be interviewing GMWs this month.
2. **Mariah Cote, Center Director II, Paradise Hills** – The Halloween Carnival is scheduled on October 28th from 4-6pm. Youth volleyball and football teams are doing well. Staff are creating shirts for the youth flag football teams and cheer squad using the site's Cricut machine.
3. **Elleese Filmore, Bay Terrace Community & Senior Center** –The upcoming Halloween Movies in the Park event is to take place on October 7th with activities beginning at 5pm. Every 2nd Saturday Bay Terraces is offering a free gardening program from 10-11am.
4. **Alissa Cordova, Center Director I, Penn Athletic Field** – Penn will be hosting a Pumpkin Carving event with Halloween games. Fall programs are in full swing with yoga, arts and crafts and a DIY Club. Penn Athletic Field Rec Center roof was replaced, and the building is being repainted inside and out.
