**Paradise Hills Native Garden** – Nancy Jansen reported, an "I Love a Clean San Diego" event hosting on September 23<sup>rd</sup>, at the Paradise Hills Native Garden. SDG&E will be sponsoring a tool shed at the Paradise Hills Native Garden as well as providing all the tools to fill the shed.

#### PARKS AND RECREATION STAFF REPORTS

**Mariah Cote, Center Director II, Paradise Hills**- 9 weeks of successful summer camp with 24 kids registered in each week. Paradise Hills/Bay Terraces 12U Softball team came in 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the City-Wide Softball playoffs. Paradise Hills also hosted their annual Teen-Nite averaging about 70-100 kids every Friday night for 8 weeks during the summer. Fall registration opened on August 19<sup>th</sup> and all fall programs are currently full.

Kemii Soundara, Center Director I, Bay Terrace Community & Senior Center – Kemii Soundara reported on behalf of Area Manager, Paradise Hills Dog Park contractors installed the last maintenance gate, and all policy and regulations signs should be installed by Friday. More trash cans and doggie bag dispensers will be added as well. A few maintenance staff were rotated: Pablo Guzman is assigned to Paradise Hills, Raul Rodriguez is assigned to Bay Terraces, Bradley Battles is assigned to Lomita, Audubon and Officer Wilson Community Park. Ron will also be getting a new Grounds Maintenance Supervisor either in September or October. New solar power security lights were installed at Parkside Neighborhood Park during the summer. As for Bay Terraces Community & Senior Center, we had a great turn out for our Movies in the Park both in June and July averaging about 100 participants. We had a great Culture Night Event Sponsored by the San Diego's Park Foundation which had about 300 participants. We have added 2 new programs to our fall list including Youth Polynesian Dancing and Youth Self Defense class which is currently full.

**Jordan Raby, OCA Center Director I, Penn Athletic Field** – Building renovation being done at Penn Athletic Field Rec Center, and Penn is currently recruiting for 10U Flag football and 14U Volleyball. Penn is also working on creating more teen programs such as teen intricate cooking and enhancing the teen center facility.
