Beach Fire Ring Rules, Location, and Count

Fires on City of San Diego Beaches

- Fires on beaches can only be built in City provided fire rings or portable barbeque or similar devices.
- Only charcoal, clean wood, or paper can be burned (no pallets or rubbish).
- Do not leave a fire burning unattended. Wait until the fire has burned out or extinguish it with water. Do not use sand to put a fire out.
- Ashes or coals in a portable barbeque must be deposited in a hot coal bin or removed from the beach.
- No beach fires between 12:00 am and 5:00 am.
- Fire rings are available on a first come, first served basis.
