Beach Fire Ring Rules, Location, and Count

Fires on City of San Diego Beaches

- Only charcoal or clean wood may be used in fire rings. Absolutely no palettes, paper, yard waste or construction waste may be used.
- Do not leave a fire burning unattended. Wait until the fire has burned out or extinguish it with water. Do not use sand to put a fire out.
- Ashes or coals from portable barbeques must be deposited in one of the city provided hot coal containers located throughout the parks or placed in city provided fire rings. NOTE-There are no coal contains on Fiesta Island so ashes and coals must placed in city provided fire rings or removed from the park entirely.
- No beach fires between 12:00 am and 5:00 am.
- Fire rings are available on a first come, first served basis.
