HOW TO SPEAK TO A PARTICULAR ITEM DURING PUBLIC COMMENT:

In Person for Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment: Please fill out a speaker slip located at the entrance to the meeting. Indicate the item you wish to speak on as well as other requested information. Then submit it to the Chairperson at the box indicated near the speaker's lectern at the front of the room.

<u>Via Virtual Platform for Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment:</u> When the Chairperson introduces the item (or indicates it is time for Non-Agenda Public Comment), raise your hand by either tapping the "Raise Your Hand" button on your computer, tablet, or Smartphone, or by dialing *9 on your phone. You will be taken in the order in which you raised your hand. You may only speak once on a particular item.

When the Chairperson indicates it is your turn to speak, unmute your phone by tapping the Unmute button on your computer, tablet or Smartphone, or dial *6 on your phone.

Please Note: Members of the public who wish to provide virtual testimony must enter the virtual queue by raising their hand before the queue closes. The queue will close when the last virtual speaker finishes speaking or five minutes after in-person testimony ends, whichever happens first. **Those participating virtually may NOT cede time to others participating in person or virtually.**

HOW TO PROVIDE WRITTEN COMMENTS:

For Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment: Submit using the webform indicating the comment type and item number (if relevant). Comments received by 7:00 AM, the day of the meeting will be distributed to the Planning Commission and posted online with the meeting materials. All webform comments are limited to 200 words but may include attachments. Comments received after the deadlines described above but before the item is called will be submitted into the written record for the relevant item. Please go to the Planning Commission website for further instructions.

Written Materials: Instead of submitting materials as an attachment to the <u>webform</u>, you may submit via U.S. Mail to the Planning Commission at 1222 First Avenue, MS 501 San Diego, CA 92101. Appeal of the Hearing Officer decision approving a Coastal Development Permit and Neighborhood Development Permit for the demolition of an existing structure to allow expansion of adjacent retail space. The 0.09-acre site is located at 3757 Mission Boulevard and 810 Queenstown Court. The project is in the MBPD-NC-N and Coastal Overlay (Appealable) Zone and Coastal Height Limitation and Parking Impact (Coastal) Zones within the Mission Beach Community Plan area. ICU (Rady Children's Hospital): A Process 4 approval of Planned Development Permit, Site Development Permit, and Conditional Use Permit amending Conditional Use Permit No. 4741, Site Development Permit No. 4742, and Planned Development Permit No. 267312 to allow the demolition of existing hospital facilities and the construction of a new seven-story, 486,000-square-foot Intensive Care Unit (ICU) and Emergency Services Pavilion, a new 36,000-square-foot Central Utility Plant, relocation of an existing heliport to the new ICU building, and a new 33,500-square-foot Connector Building on the Rady Children's Hospital - San Diego (RCHSD) main campus. The 27.47-acre site is zoned CO-1-2 and is located at 2929/3010/3020/3030/3065 Childrens Way, 8105 Birmingham Way, and 3101 Berger Avenue in the Serra Mesa Community Planning Area. An Addendum to Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) No. 84791 was prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15162 and 15164. No changes in circumstances have occurred, and no new information of substantial importance has manifested, which would result in new significant or substantially increased adverse impacts as a result of the project.
