## What to Know About Prop. 64

## Who is allowed to legally possess marijuana?

- Persons <u>21 years and older</u> may legally possess up to 28.5 grams of marijuana and up to 8 grams of concentrated cannabis. Any amounts possessed over these limits is a CRIME.
- Persons **<u>21 years and older</u>** may also lawfully possess, purchase, obtain, or use marijuana accessories.

### Where can marijuana be legally smoked or consumed?

- Marijuana **cannot** be consumed in public, any public place, or any location where smoking tobacco is prohibited.
- Smoking marijuana or marijuana products IS NOT ALLOWED within 1,000 feet of a school, day care center, or youth center while children are present unless in a private residence and only if such smoking is not detectable by others on the grounds of such a school, day care center, or youth center while children are present.
- Smoking or consuming marijuana IS NOT ALLOWED while driving or while riding in the passenger seat or compartment of an operating a motor vehicle, boat, vessel, aircraft, or other vehicle used for transportation.

### Who can legally cultivate (grow) marijuana?

- You must be <u>**21 years and older**</u> to cultivate up to **6** living marijuana plants at a time inside of a private residence or within an accessory structure. The accessory structure must be secured and fully enclosed (I.E. locked greenhouse or shed).
- It is a **CRIME** for persons **<u>21 years and older</u>** to cultivate more than 6 living marijuana plants.
- Persons UNDER 21 are not allowed to cultivate (grow) marijuana.

#### Who can sell marijuana?

- Only a state licensed and city permitted marijuana outlet may sell marijuana.
- Sales of marijuana by anyone besides a licensed and permitted outlet is a **CRIME**.
