

SMART PEDESTRIANS:

- Walk without distractions
- Use crosswalks or intersections at all times
- Look left, right, and left again before crossing
- Expect the unexpected

BE AWARE, PEDESTRIANS DON'T HAVE ARMOR

FACTS ABOUT CROSSWALK SIGNALS



The **WALKING PERSON** that appears on the pedestrian signal lets you know you can cross the street.

When the **UPRAISED HAND** begins flashing, you have enough time to finish crossing, but don't leave the curb if you haven't started crossing.



When the **UPRAISED HAND** is solid, you should already be across the street or still on the curb.

A **COUNTDOWN** signal lets you know how much time you have left to cross the intersection, but don't leave the curb if you haven't started crossing.

Even when the sign indicates it's safe to walk, **LOOK BOTH WAYS** and make sure a driver sees you before stepping off the curb.
