AND WHEREAS said bicycle racks are a very great convenience to the riding and driving public in that the wheelmen, by placing their bicycles in said racks are not only enabled to protect their said bicycles from damage by the teams using said streets, but are also able to save the teamsters and drivers using said streets much annoyance and trouble caused by wheels being left along the curbstones often times very near or in front of the hitching posts designed for the use of said teamsters and drivers,

AND WHEREAS the danger of horses being frightened by the falling of wheels so placed along said curb is, by the use of said racks, to a great extent averted;

AND WHEREAS the City Attorney of said City has ordered said bicycle racks removed from said sidewalks;

THEREFORE, we, the undersigned, CITIZENS of THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO aforesaid, hereby REQUEST and PETITION your honorable body to grant said dealers and any other persons permission to place said bicycle racks along the curbs of said side walks in said City
