Gentlemen:

The B. P. O. Elks, No. 168, of San Diego, will hold a picnic at El Monte Park June twenty-ninth, 1941.

In connection therewith, the Board of Trustees of said organization has authorized the picnic committee to arrange for a bicycle race on that date. The race, if proper permission is granted, will start from Park Boulevard and Laurel Street at 9:00 A. M.

The course selected is as follows: From Laurel Street north on Park Boulevard to El Cajon Boulevard; east on El Cajon Boulevard to the City of El Cajon; thence, left through Santee to Lakeside; up the dirt road to the entrance to El Monte Park.

All entrants will be required to sign a document releasing promoters and sponsors from any and all liability for any harm that may occur to all personnel and equipment participating in the event.

If the event is permitted, proper police supervision will be provided.

The contest will be governed by the rules of the Amateur Bicycle League of America.
