The undersigned respectfully petitions
your Honorable Body as follows:

To declare a certain route known as the
Coast Line, from City limits near Del Mar through
Torrey Pines, La Jolla, Pacific Beach, Marino, Old
Town, India Street to "C" Street, up "C" Street
to Twelfth Street, through the City Park to El
Cajon Boulevard, out El Cajon Boulevard to City
Limits, closed to the public, for the purpose of
holding the San Diego Exposition Los Angeles
to Phoenix Race, between the hours of eight
and twelve on the morning of Monday, November
3rd, 1913, and further that you direct the
Police Authorities of the City of San Diego to
lend the Race Committee every assistance possible
that the Public may have due notice thereof.
