The undersigned respectfully petition as follows:



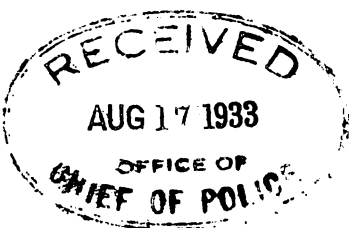
