The undersigned respectfully petitions as follows: That you reconsider your former vote of rescinding my license for a dance hall at 636 Market Street, San Diego, California, for the following reasons:

1. My dance hall had a good police report.
2. My livelihood for myself, wife and two children depends on this business.
3. My dance hall helps keep the Philipinos segregated, and provides a place for them to have social entertainment.
4. That the method of employing instructors is exactly the same as used by other dance halls which are now licensed.
5. My license fee is paid to June 30, 1934.
