To the San Diego City Council:

We, the undersigned duly registered voters of the Southeastern section of the City of San Diego, take this opportunity and this means of reminding you that the children of this area are in dire need of additional recreational facilities, and are in particular need of a place where they can swim. Of all the sports indulged in by youngsters, the dearest to their hearts is swimming. Yet, our children have no place where they can swim!! The beaches are out of the question in view of the transportation situation, and are unfit and unsafe for youngsters in view of the undertow which exacts its toll of dead each year.

A glance at your allotment of recreational facilities throughout the city will show that other areas have been more than adequately provided for in comparison to the allotment for the Southeastern section.

We therefore petition you to construct a swimming pool on the park grounds adjacent to Logan and Memorial Schools where our children may swim without fear of losing their lives.
