### Offsite Storm Water Alternative Compliance Program for Meeting New Development Requirements

The Municipal Permit provides Offsite Storm Water Alternative Compliance as an option for Priority Development Projects in lieu of implementing onsite structural BMPs to comply with pollutant control and hydromodification management requirements. The City will implement the offsite storm water alternative compliance program in two phases:

**Phase 1:** Applicant Implemented Alternative Compliance Projects where the project applicant would propose an offsite alternative compliance project and be fully responsible for the project's design, construction, operation, and long term maintenance. Phase 1 implementation coincides with February 16, 2016, the effective date of the Storm Water Standards Manual Update.

**Phase 2:** Independent Alternative Compliance Projects includes another option, credit trading system. This phase is currently in the initial planning stage.
