
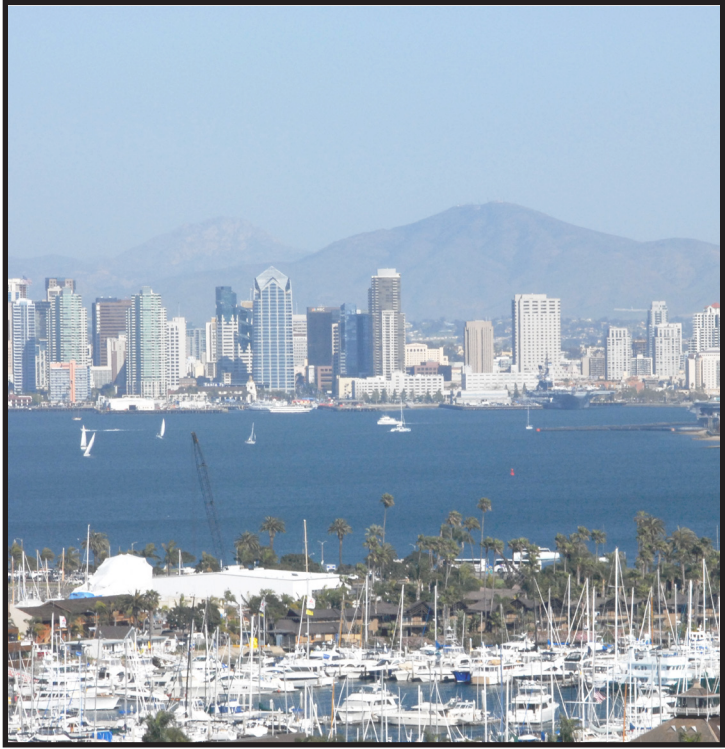



- 174,673 sites identified for housing







10 active public-private partnerships


