Said vacancy exists as of: **FEBRUARY 11, 2022.** This notice is posted as of: **FEBRUARY 15, 2022.**

Final appointment to the board, commission, or committee shall not be made by the City Council for at least 10 working days after the posting of the notice by the City Clerk's office. That date will be: **MARCH 2, 2022.**

This commission shall be filled by appointment by the city council of the city from which the vacancy has occurred. Any appointment to fill a vacancy during the term of a commissioner shall be for the unexpired term, with confirmation required by the City Council.

Whenever an unscheduled vacancy occurs in any board, commission, or committee for which the City Council has the appointing power, whether due to resignation, death, termination, or other causes, a special vacancy notice shall be posted in the City Clerk's Office, the San Diego Central Library, and in other places as directed by the City Council, not earlier than 20 days before or not later than 20 days after the vacancy occurs. Final appointment to the board, commission, or committee shall not be made by the City Council for at least 10 working days after the posting of the notice in the City Clerk's Office. [Gov. Code Sec. 54974 (a)]

Notwithstanding the above provisions, the City Council may, if it finds that an emergency exists, fill the unscheduled vacancy immediately. Persons appointed to fill such a vacancy shall serve only on an acting basis until the final appointment is made pursuant to Gov. Code Sec. 54974.
