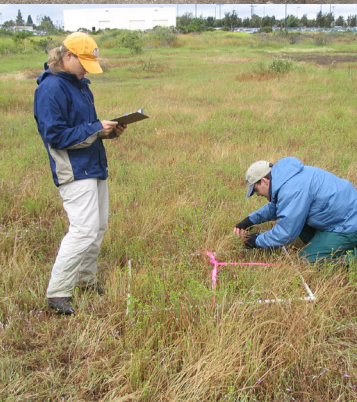
Citywide Maintenance
