Police Investigate Homicide In Southcrest Neighborhood

San Diego – On February 8, 2020, at approximately 12:04 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a 911 call regarding a possible shooting at the Southcrest Community Park. When the responding officers arrived on scene, they found a man and a woman who both sustained apparent gunshot wounds. San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel also responded to the scene and transported both victims to a local hospital for treatment. Unfortunately, the woman did not survive her injuries and was pronounced deceased at the hospital at 1:08 a.m. The man underwent emergency surgery and is expected to survive.

Investigators from the San Diego Police Homicide Unit were called to the scene to investigate. Although it is very early in the investigation and little is known about the events leading up to the incident, this does not appear to be a random act of violence. Investigators will be processing the scene for evidence and interviewing potential witnesses.

Neither victim has been identified at this time. The woman was described as a possible Hispanic female in her twenties. The man was described as a possible Hispanic male in his late teens to early twenties.

The only suspect description at this time is two Hispanic males in their twenties, wearing dark clothing.
