Man Arrested for Attempted Bank Robbery

San Diego – Even in these challenging times, you can count on SDPD to continue fighting crime. Our officers arrested a man for attempted bank robbery.

Yesterday at about 2:45 p.m., 30-year-old Juan Navarro entered the Bank of America located at 11855 Carmel Mountain Road. He handed the teller a demand note but walked away as the teller approached the bank manager. Detectives from our Robbery Unit along with agents with the San Diego Field Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigations responded to the bank to conduct their investigation. Approximately 45 minutes later, SDPD Communications Center received a call from a community member who saw Navarro trying to break into cars parked along 14000 Montfort Circle. Officers responded and after a short foot pursuit, found, and detained Navarro. He was identified as the man who attempted to rob the Bank of America. Navarro was placed under arrest and booked into County Jail.
