Seeking Community Help on Felony Hit and Run Investigation

San Diego – The San Diego Police Department is seeking help from the community regarding a hit and run traffic collision which resulted in a man suffering life threatening injuries.

On May 5, 2020 at about 7 p.m., a 56-year-old man was standing on the corner of Copeland Avenue and El Cajon Boulevard in the Kensington neighborhood. The light turned green for Copeland Avenue and the man began walking in the marked crosswalk when he was struck by a vehicle which ran a red light. The driver did not stop and continued west away from the collision scene. The vehicle is described as a late model white Ford Explorer. The driver's description is unknown. The photo below is of the actual suspect vehicle which was retrieved from a nearby business. The vehicle is missing the passenger side mirror.
