Police Investigating Homicide in College East Neighborhood

San Diego – Just before 7:30 p.m. on May 27, 2020, the San Diego Police Communications Division began receiving 911 calls regarding a possible shooting in an apartment in the 6600 block of Montezuma Road. When the officers arrived on scene, they located two men inside an apartment who had sustained apparent gunshot wounds. Unfortunately, one of the men was pronounced deceased inside the apartment. The second man was transported to a local hospital where he is undergoing emergency surgery.

Investigators from the San Diego Police Homicide Unit were called to the scene. It is still very early in the investigation but we have learned there were two black males in their late teens to early twenties seen jumping a fence and running from the scene just after the shots were fired. Investigators have been on scene throughout the evening collecting evidence and interviewing potential witnesses to determine what led to the shooting.

Neither victim has been positively identified at this point. They appear to be white males in their twenties.
