### **Police Investigate Homicide in Southcrest Park**

**San Diego** – at 10:15 p.m. on June 5, 2020, the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call about a possible deceased person at 1300 S. 40<sup>th</sup> Street in the Southcrest Community Park.

Officers arrived at the location and were contacted by a citizen who directed them to a male with apparent trauma, possibly gunshot injuries, to his upper body. The citizen had found the male while walking nearby. San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel arrived on scene and began life-saving efforts, but unfortunately, the male was pronounced deceased at the scene.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. It is early in the investigation and little is known about the circumstances surrounding the man's death. Detectives are collecting evidence and attempting to locate witnesses.

The male has been identified, however his name is not being released at this time. He is described as a 28 year-old black male who was known to frequent the area.
