Arrests made in Home Invasion Robbery

San Diego – On July 24, 2019, at 2:30 p.m., San Diego Police officers responded to a home invasion robbery at 4600 Firestone Street. Three suspects entered the residence of the 87-year-old victim. They beat and robbed the victim and took his 2007 burgundy Honda Ridgeline. The victim was transported to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. This case was assigned to the San Diego Police Department Robbery Unit for investigation.

On July 25, 2019, San Diego Police officers responded to a call of a suspicious vehicle at 2900 Adrian Street. Police contacted two subjects inside a reported stolen Dodge Ram truck. Both subjects had felony warrants and a firearm was recovered. They were arrested without incident. They were identified as John Slobig (DOB: 09/14/1959) and Terry Jones (DOB: 12/08/1965). Robbery detectives responded to the scene.

After an extensive investigation, it has been determined that both Slobig and Jones are suspects in the home invasion robbery from July 24, 2019. Today, both suspects were charged with robbery, elder abuse and auto theft. The victim's Honda Ridgeline has also been recovered. A third suspect is still outstanding and detectives are still investigating this incident to determine their identity and whereabouts.
