Arrest of Robbery Suspect

San Diego – On July 22, 2019 at 6:30 a.m., San Diego Police officers responded to 3101 National Avenue to investigate an armed robbery at the Ideal Market. A Hispanic male entered the business holding a pistol demanding lottery scratchers. The suspect had his face covered with a t-shirt. The clerk complied with the demands and the suspect took lottery scratchers and left the market.

The case was investigated by the San Diego Police Robbery Unit. During the investigation, the suspect was identified as Daniel Martinez (DOB: 12/22/1998).

Today at 10:00 a.m., robbery detectives saw Daniel Martinez at 3100 National Avenue. With the assistance of Central Division patrol officers, Martinez was taken into custody without incident. Martinez was booked into San Diego County Jail and charged with armed robbery.
