San Diego Police Investigate Homicide in the Chollas Creek Neighborhood

San Diego - On Wednesday, August 28, 2019 at 10:32 p.m., the San Diego Police Department's Communication Center received a call of a person down at Ogden Street and Shiloh Street.

Officers arrived on scene a few minutes later and learned that San Diego Fire Department paramedics also responded to the scene and had already transported a young man with at least one gunshot wound to his body to the hospital. Unfortunately, the man succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased at the hospital.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene to investigate the incident. A witness discovered the young man in the north alley of 5200 Ogden Street and called 911. Through witness statements, we learned earlier in the evening, gunshots were heard in the area. A light colored sedan was also seen in the area about the time the shots were heard.

The victim has not been identified. He appears to be a light skinned young Black male possibly in his late teens or early twenties.
