Police Investigate Possible Overdose Death in the Scripps Ranch Neighborhood

San Diego – On August 31, 2019 at approximately 8:32 p.m., the San Diego Police Department’s Communications Center received a call requesting officers check the welfare of a male at 10330 Ridgewater Lane in the Scripps Ranch neighborhood. The reporting party stated she was unable to reach her friend and became concerned prompting the call to police.

San Diego Police officers arrived on scene and entered the home. They found the body of a deceased male inside. It appeared to be an overdose. A Medical Examiner investigator arrived on scene. Their preliminary investigation resulted in many unanswered questions, prompting the Homicide Unit to respond. Detectives will be working with the Medical Examiner’s Office to determine the manner and cause of death.

The victim has been identified but his identity will not be released pending family notification.
