Police Investigating Homicide In Midway Area

San Diego – At approximately 8:00 a.m. on November 28, 2019, the San Diego Police Department Communications Center received a call of an injured man in the 3100 block of Sports Arena Boulevard. When the officers arrived, they found a man with significant trauma to his neck. The man was transported to a hospital but unfortunately did not survive his injuries.

Homicide investigators were called to the scene and will be handling the investigation. Although it is very early in the investigation, it appears the victim had an altercation with another male outside of the business. At some point in the altercation, the suspect used an unknown weapon to cause significant injuries to the victim's neck area. The suspect was last seen walking away from the scene.

The victim has been identified but his name is not being released at this time pending notification of his family. The victim was a 55 year-old man.

The suspect is described as a white male between twenty and forty years old. He was seen wearing a dark hooded sweatshirt, blue digital camouflage pants and a blue hospital mask. He was also wearing a backpack. The image below is believed to be the suspect and was retrieved from surveillance footage.
