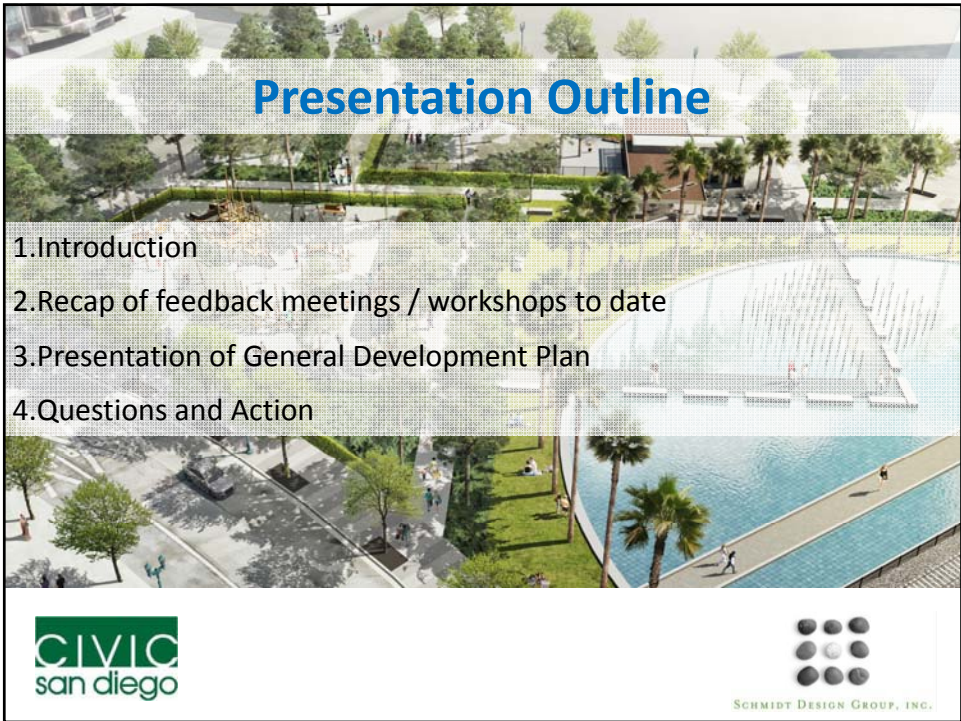

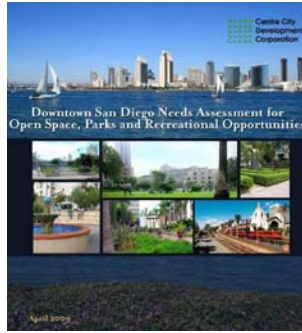

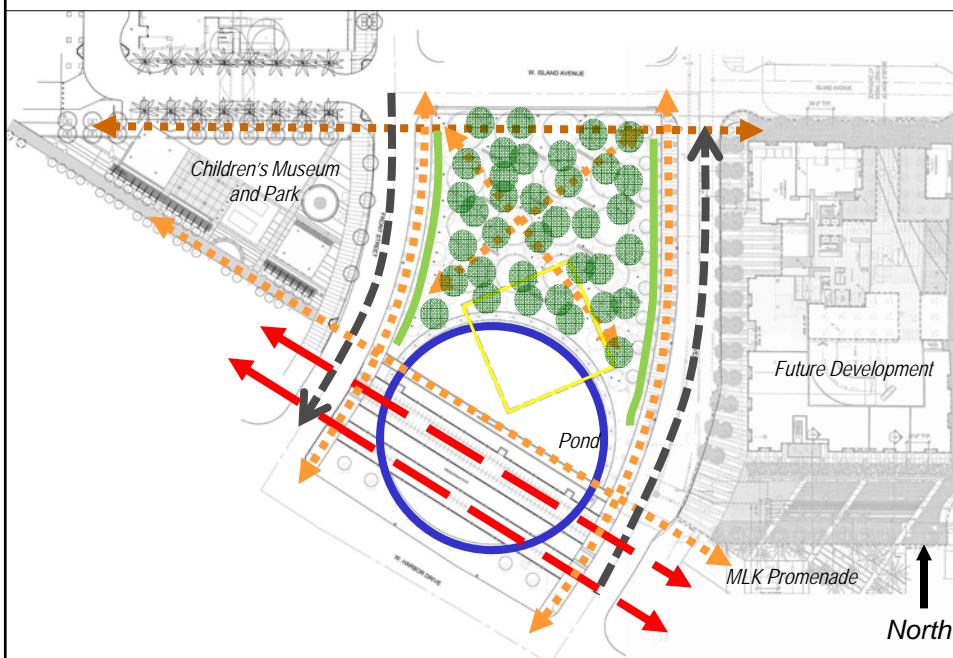


## Marina Neighborhood

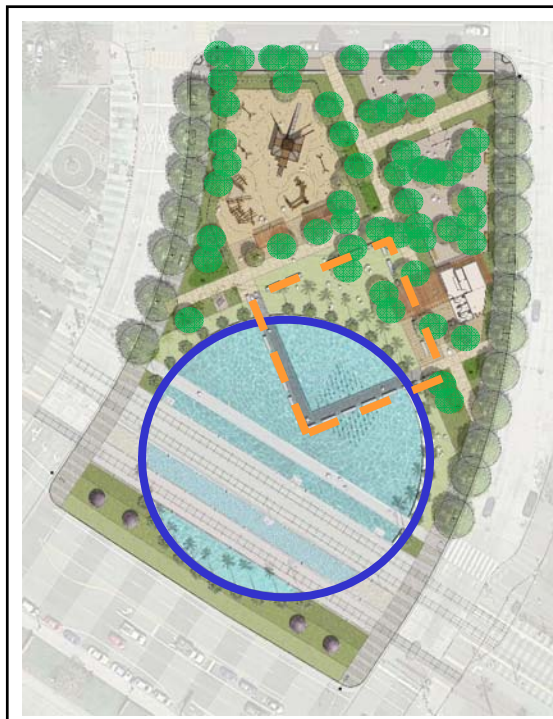

## Children's Park General Development Plan

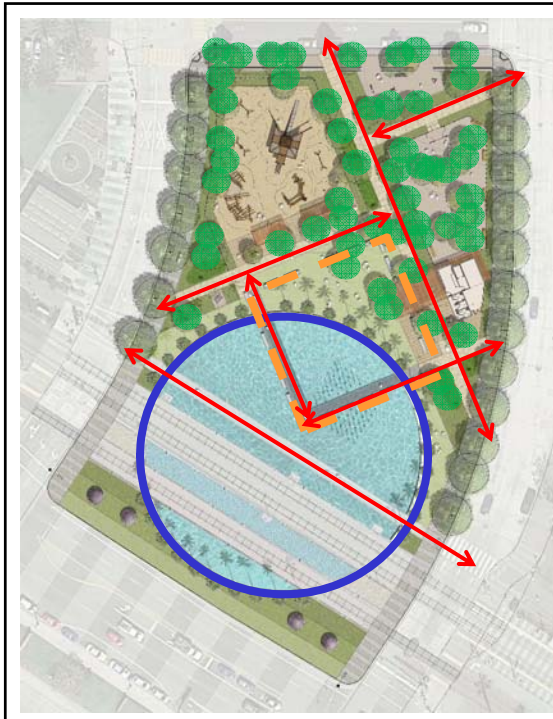
- Retains civic pond

Structure of original design retained with civic pond, stone benches and urban forest (thinned)

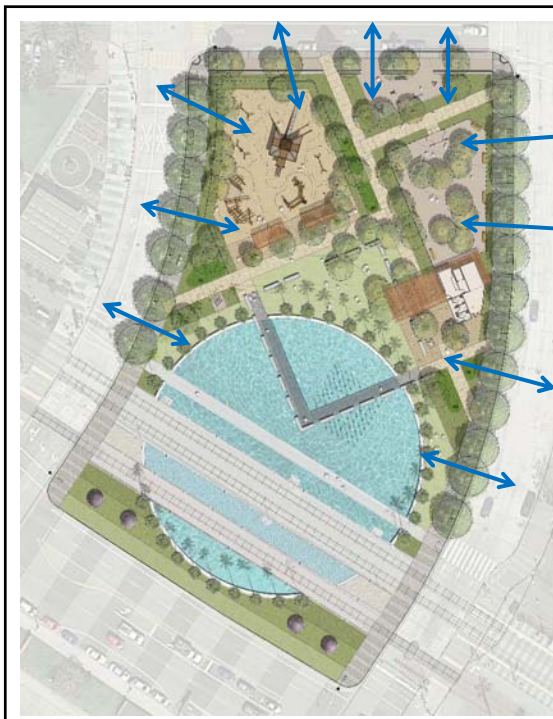

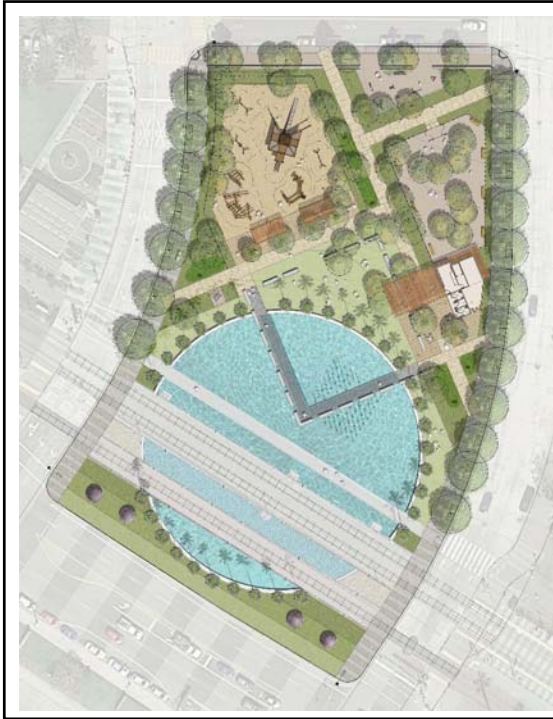
Structure of original design retained with civic pond, stone benches and urban forest (thinned)

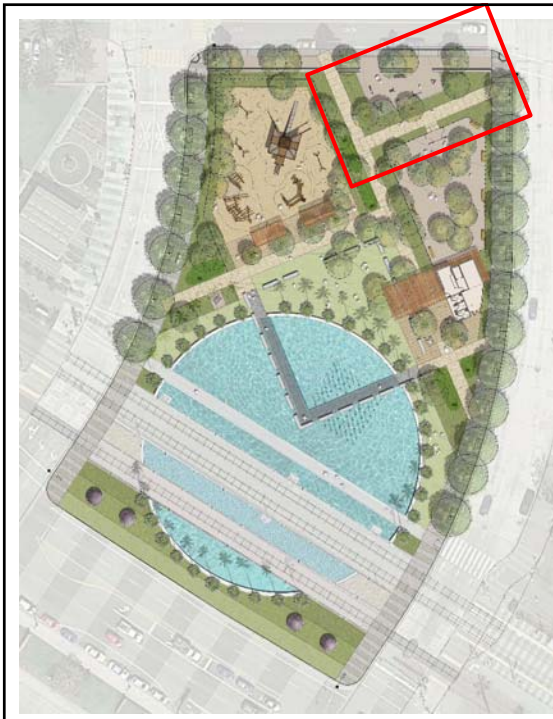

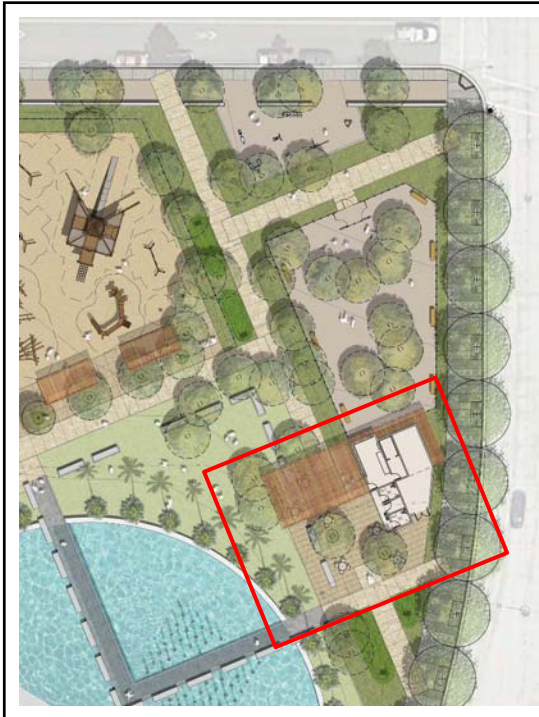

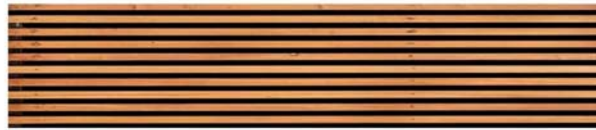

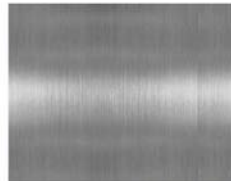

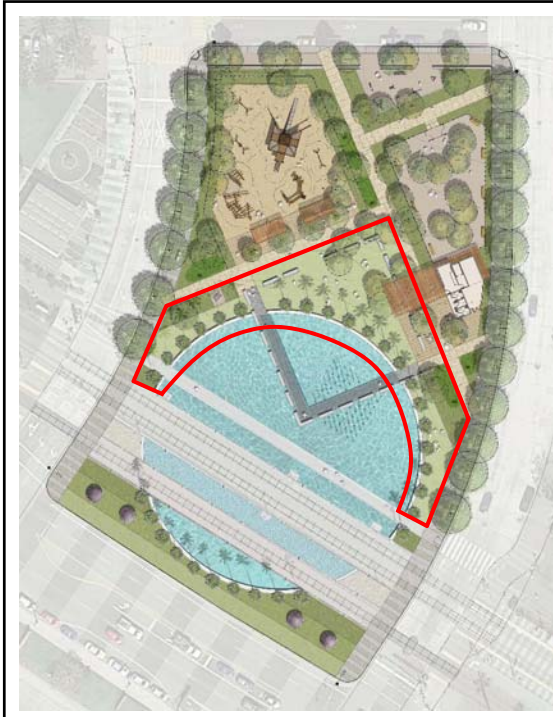

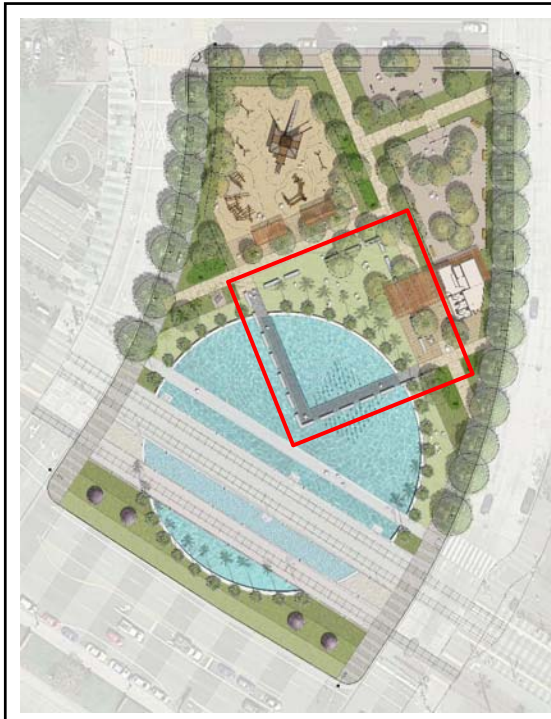
