<u>SUMMARY</u>		

<u>Issue</u>: Should the Park and Recreation Board recommend approval of the General Development Plan (GDP) Amendment for John F. Kennedy Neighborhood Park to include a picnic shelter?

<u>Director's Recommendation</u> – Recommend approval of the proposed GDP Amendment for John F. Kennedy Neighborhood Park to include a picnic shelter.

<u>Other Recommendations</u> – The following groups have reviewed and considered the proposed project. Actions taken and recommendations made by these groups are listed under Discussion below.

• On August 16, 2018 the Martin Luther King Recreation Council voted unanimously (3-0-0) recommending approval of the proposed GDP Amendment.

<u>Fiscal Impact</u> – The total project budget is approximately \$1.9 million. Funding for the proposed project is available from the Encanto Neighborhood Developer Impact Funds (DIF). There is no anticipated increase to the annual operational budget.

<u>Water and Energy Conservation Status</u> – The proposed John F. Kennedy Neighborhood Park Picnic Shelter complies with all water and energy conservation guidelines contained in Council Policy 200-14.

<u>Environmental</u> - This activity is Statutorily Exempt from CEQA, pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines, Section 15262 (Feasibility and Planning Studies).

BACKGROUND

This project provides for the design and construction of a new picnic shelter as well as improvements to the existing tot lot, restroom and associated accessibility (ADA) path of travel improvements within the John F. Kennedy Neighborhood Park.

DISCUSSION

Public Works Department staff and the designer conducted a public workshop with the community. The meeting was focused on the conceptual design for the park improvements including the picnic shelter. During the community workshop, City staff and the consultant provided concepts of proposed amenities and the picnic shelter.

The proposed GDP Amendment before the Board is a product of consensus achieved through the meeting as well as substantial design development undertaken by staff, the community, and project designers.

The proposed General Development Plan Amendment improvements includes construction of a new picnic shelter within the John F. Kennedy Neighborhood Park.

The primary issues raised during community input meetings was that the community wanted more lighting for the park. To mitigate these concerns PWD have coordinated with Environmental Services Department (ESD) on a separate lighting upgrade project they have scheduled to be completed by December 2018. Additional park lighting has been added to the scope of the project to address concerns.

- 1. Recommend approval of the General Development Plan (GDP) Amendment for John F. Kennedy Neighborhood Park.
- 2. Recommend approval of the General Development Plan (GDP) Amendment for John F. Kennedy Neighborhood Park with modifications.


