RE: Letter of support for Sunset Cliffs Park Drainage Improvements, CIP# L14005

The Peninsula Community Planning Board (PCPB) requests that the City of San Diego support the Sunset Cliffs Natural Park Council in its bid for a share of the Fiscal Year 2023 budget money allocated to regional parks. Some \$4 million of revenue has been generated by Mission Bay commercial enterprises and is available to the large regional parks. Since 2016, Sunset Cliffs has been trying to get funds for design work to channel runoff appropriately and curtail severe erosion problems at both the hillside and lateral portions of the park. The erosion threatens public use of the park and to collapse both Sunset Cliffs Boulevard and seaside parking lots used by residents and visitors. With an ample share of the revenues, it is believed that the design work can be completed. The next step will be actual construction, probably in a future budget.

The Peninsula Community Planning Board voted unanimously (11-0) to approve this request.
