Members of the Parks and Recreation Board:

The San Diego Parks Foundation is writing to offer its strong support for Item 101, the Bayside Community Center proposal to amend the General Development Plan of the Linda Vista Community Park to allow for the construction of a community garden. As a project partner, we are inspired by how this exciting project will benefit the local community.

The project would convert an unused dirt patch at the corner of the Linda Vista Community Park into an active green gathering space for community members. The garden will increase equitable access to green space; increase the availability of fresh, healthy produce in the community; and create a space for outdoor educational workshops.
