## Introduction

- Temporary off-leash dog park facility at for residents in the University Heights community
- Alleviate off-leash dog activity currently occurring at Birney Elementary Joint Use Field
- Will provide 0.22 acres and 18 recreation value points.





## Discussion

- The Ed Center operations will be relocating to a new facility in Kearny Mesa
- District will retain ownership of the site
- Redevelopment will likely include a permanent off-leash dog park
- A master planning community stakeholder planning process to occur

# Proposed off-leash dog park

- Not a joint use facility
- License agreement for non-exclusive City use
- Off-leash dog park will be locked at dusk
- Planned hours of operation: every day from 6am to dusk
- Existing turf and irrigation to remain

- No fencing in front of the primary facade




## Project Scope
