

Play All Day Parks Program

- Expansion of JU Program to add over 45 new joint use facilities in the next 5-10 years.
- To date, 21 Play All Day JU facilities have been opened to the public.
- 6 JUF's are in construction
- 1 JUF's in bidding
- 12 JUF's are in design


Background

Emerson Elementary School

This project provides for the design and construction of a new joint use facility at Emerson Elementary School.

Located at 1100 S. 36th Street within the Southeastern Community, Council District 9.

Will provide approx. 1.6 acres of population-based park land and 49 recreation value points.



Project Scope

Design and construction of a multi-purpose synthetic turf field, walking track, parking lot, drinking fountain, fencing and trees.

Funding for Design and Construction:

San Diego Unified School District various Capital Improvement Bond Program measures.


