
Requested Action:

Should the Parks and Recreation Board recommend approval of the Proposed General Development Plan Amendment to include a Dog Off-Leash Area (DOLA) at Allied Gardens Community Park?

Why is a DOLA Needed?



- To provide a DOLA within the Navajo community.
- To reduce vehicle miles travelled to access DOLA.
- To alleviate off-leash dog violations within Lewis Joint Use Field & Allied Gardens CP.
- To provide an additional 10.5 Recreation Value Points.





Public Input Process


Community Concerns

 There are no DOLA's within the Navajo community. Since 2019 community group 'Beyond Leashes' and Council Office 7 have been working on developing a DOLA for the Navajo community.

Community Input

- Workshop held on 9/12/22 with the Allied Gardens Community Recreation Group (CRG).
- On 11/14/22 the Allied Gardens CRG voted (9-0-0) to recommend approval of the proposed GDP Amendment.
- On 3/12/2020 Navajo Community Planners, Inc. provided a letter of support for this project.

Dog Off-Leash Area Design Elements & Amenities



ADA path of travel from street parking to shared entry vestibule. Dog drinking fountain & signage (rules & regs).



Repurposed logs for agility training, seating and dust barrier (at pool fence).



Separate fenced (chain-link) areas for large and small dogs.




Trash and recycling receptacles and dog-bag dispensers.



Heavy fence fabric at pool fence along with vegetative screening for both pool and residences Southeast of DOLA.

GDP Amendment Implementation

Project Scope

 Design and construction of a dog off-leash area with chain-link fencing, gates, existing turf and accessible path of travel access within Allied Gardens Community Park.

Funding for Design/Construction

- Funding has been requested in proposed budget that will be released later this month. Anticipated funding available July 1, 2023.

Schedule (Estimated)

- Public Input Process complete: Winter 2022
- Construction: Summer 2023
- Open for use: Late Summer/Fall 2023
