### **Community Cat Program**

Provides spay/neuter, medical examination, minor medical treatment as necessary, and vaccinations for healthy, free-roaming community cats without identifiable signs of ownership before they are returned to their outdoor homes.

### Park Patrol Program

Provides dedicated Humane Law Enforcement Officers to patrol City Joint Use, Park and Beach spaces for off leash dogs and community member engagement.

- Daily Patrol of "Top 10"
- Weekly rotation through Council Districts
- One community meeting or event monthly as requested or coordinated with City Parks Department or Council Offices





#### Community and Neighborhood Services Committee – Citation Information Request

Items to Consider if City Changes Municipal Code to Issue Administrative Citations instead of County Code (San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances)

- Does the City have authority to amend current Muni code to no longer cite County code?
- How do other cities in the region handle this issue?
- What list of animal related infractions would the City want to cite for?
- What additional processes would need to be put in place to implement administrative citations (fee schedule, appeal process, collections procedures, community service options, etc.)
- Would proposed changes require community input?
