

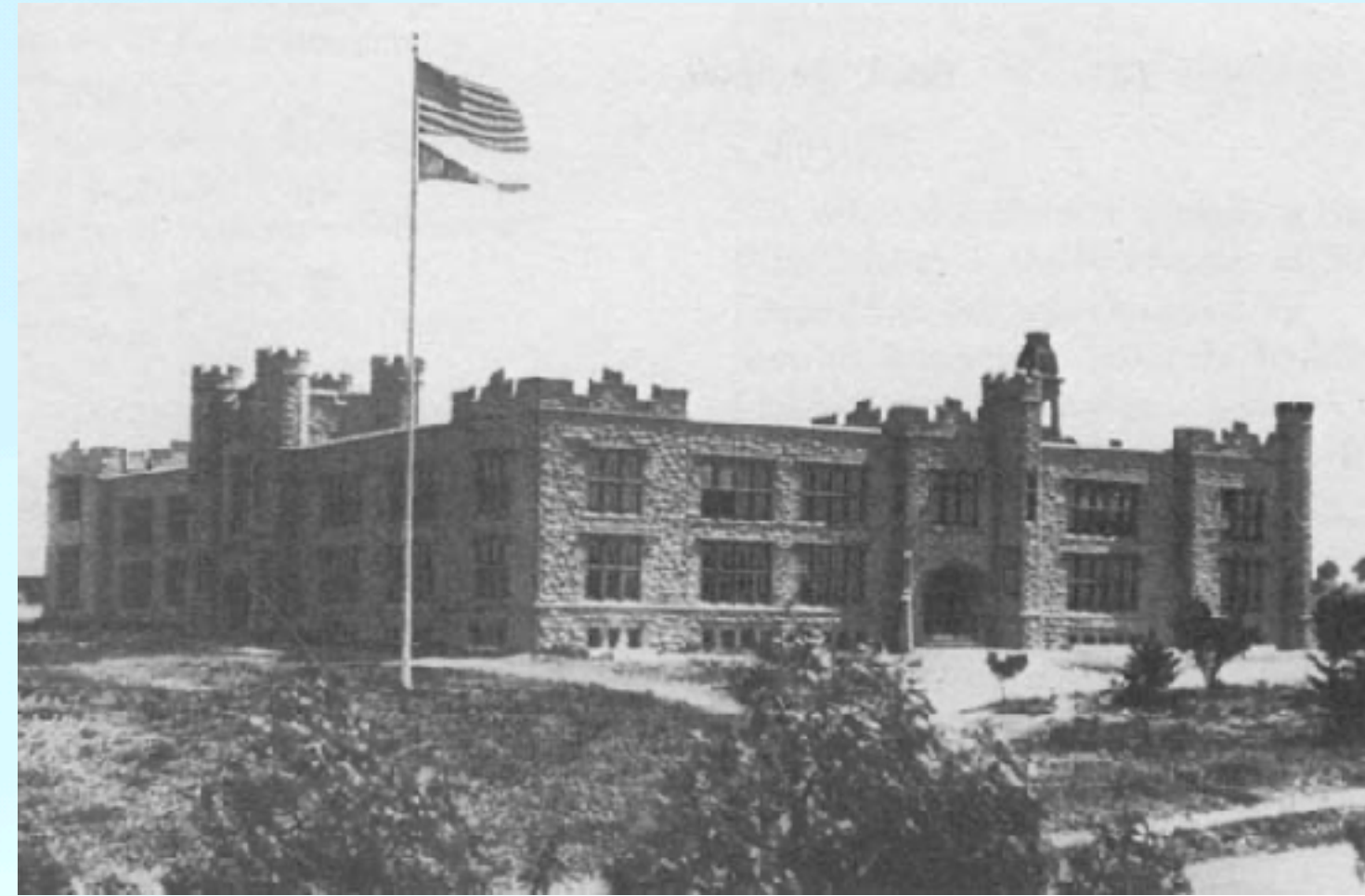

- SDHS-Balboa Park Working Group formed 2022 to explore complementary actions.

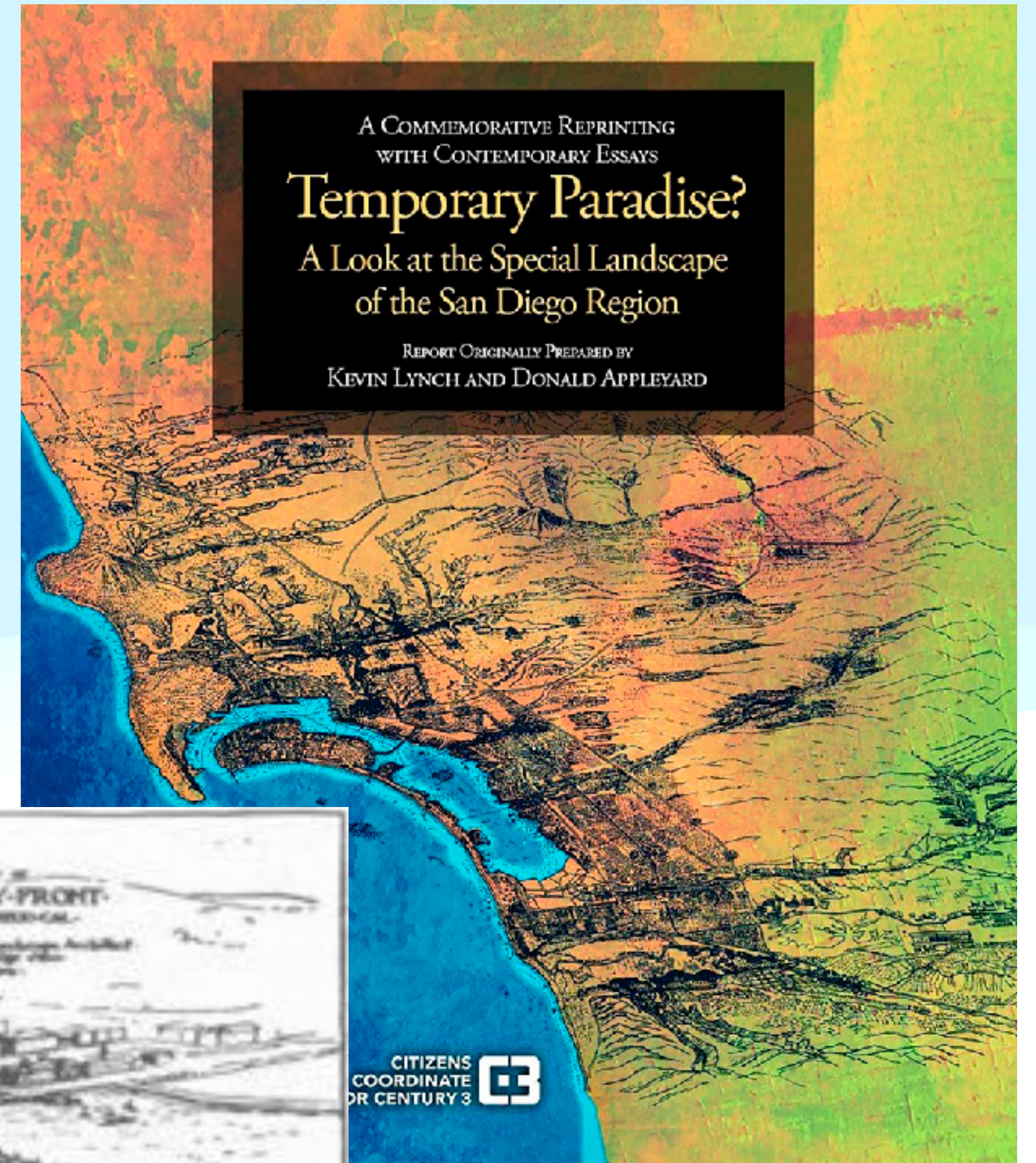

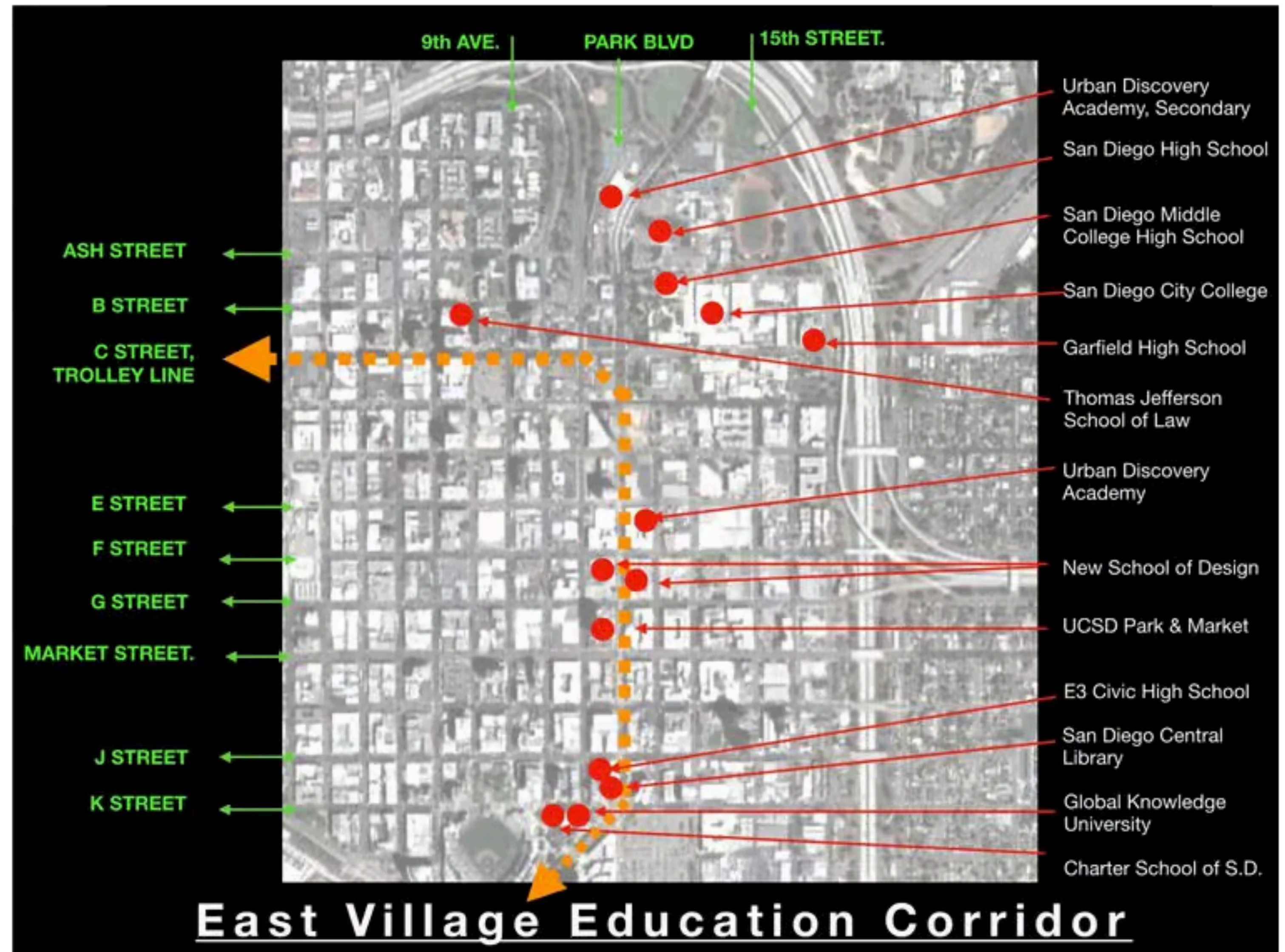

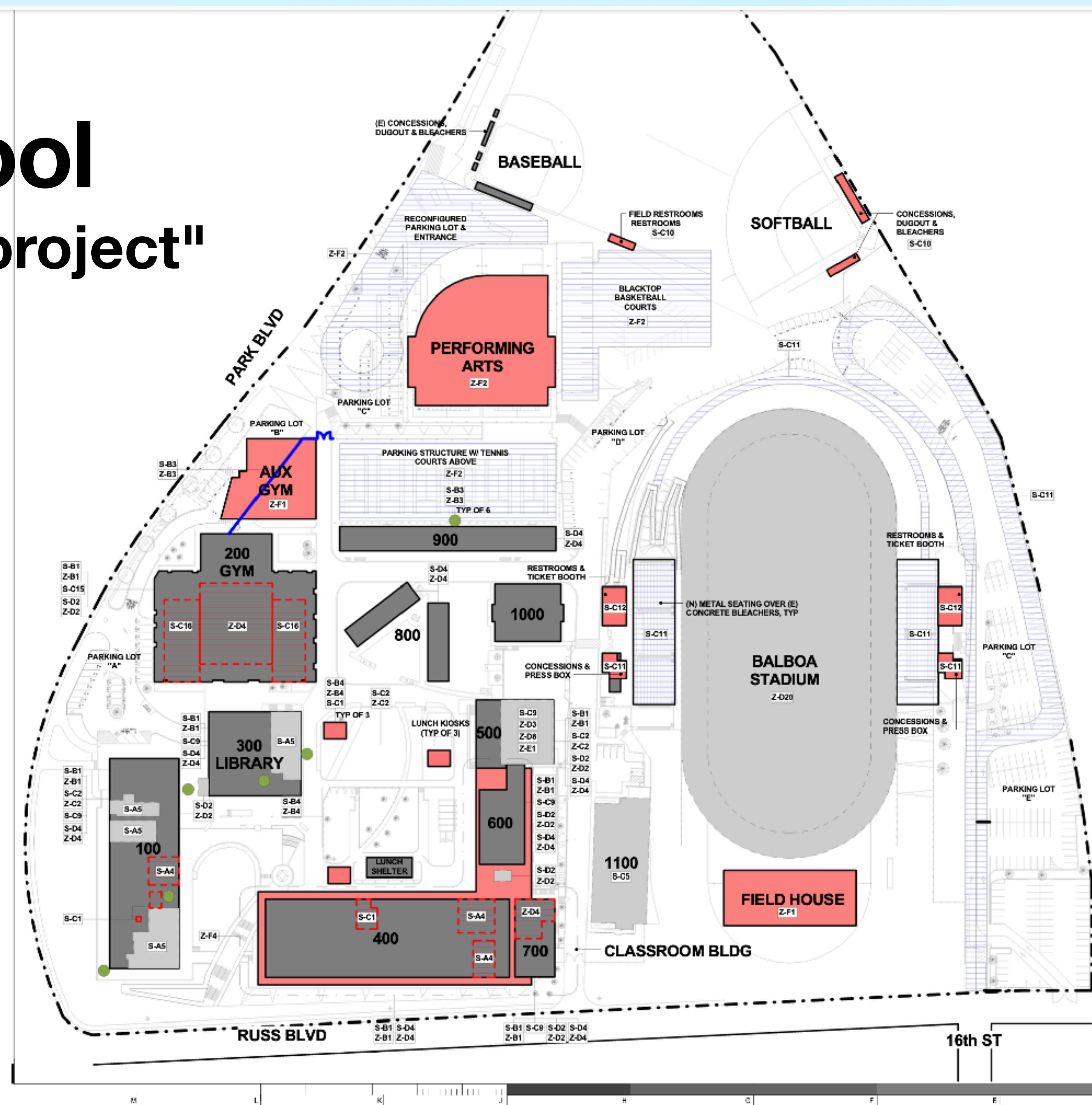
Nearly a dozen schools plus cultural institutions strung along Park Boulevard. Here's the opportunity to collaborate.

- Ideas to consider: Park Blvd. beautification, pedestrian bridge replacement, 14th Street extension, expanded internships in park



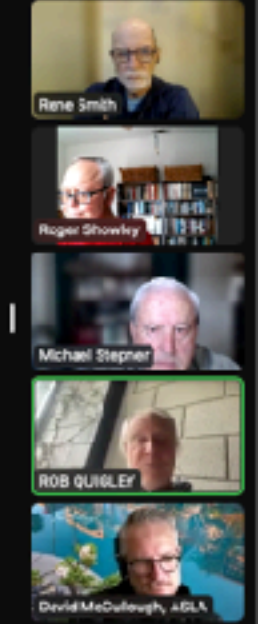

City Context



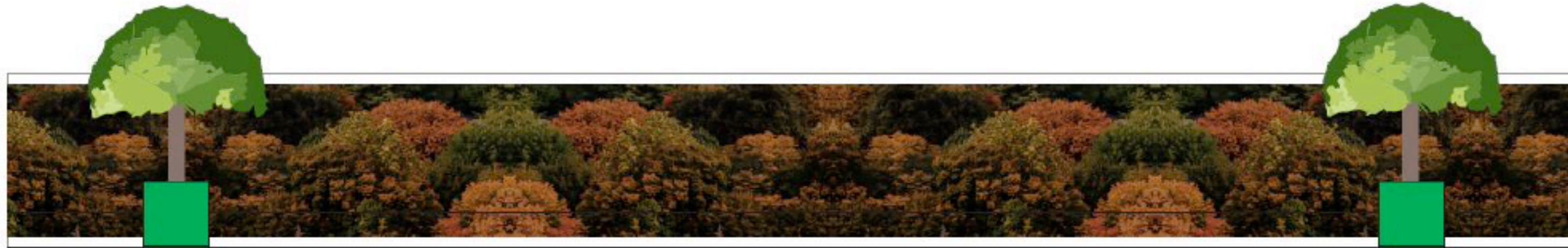

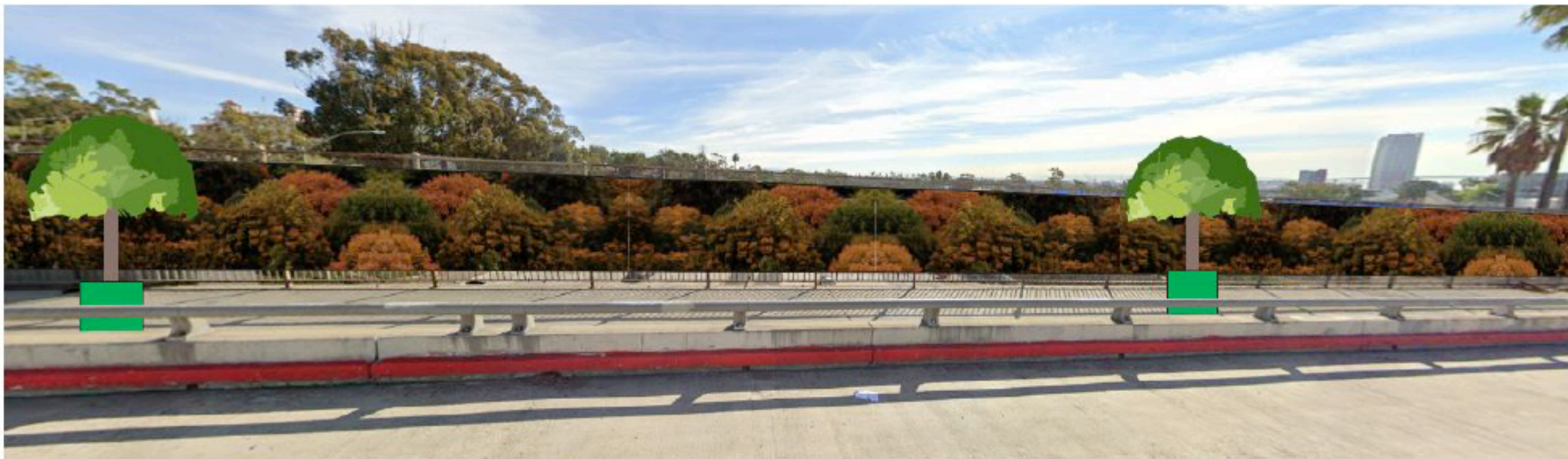
Immediate action #2
