


Public Input Process

- The motion passed with the "stipulation of looking for a larger space for the dog park in the area." The vote was unanimous (7-0-0).















Main Park Enlargement

Possible Dog-Off-Leash-Area Expansion

- The alternate option will surround the north entrance and basketball court with dog activity.
- The alternate option is very close to the playground area.
- The alternate option would locate the dog-off-leasharea directly across the street from residents.
- The alternate option comes at the expense of limited open turf area for human recreation.
