Background

- January 2018 Department established 60 recreation center funds to support recreation programs, events and enhanced maintenance
- Funds were previously held and managed by Recreation Councils

City Council Resolution R-311478 include:

- Amend the Department Fee Schedule
- Authorize the CFO to appropriate and expend Recreation Center Funds
- Designate that funds collected within a geographical area be used for recreation programs within that area
- Assume recreation council contractor agreements



COVID-19 Response

- Due to the COVID-19 epidemic, facilities closed in March 2020 and are scheduled to reopen in May and June 2021.
- Implemented over 1,000 virtual programs to more than 9,000 participants
- Served 257,449 meals during the Summer Meals Program across 17 parks.
- Hosted a variety of holiday grab-and-go events and Toys for Tots bringing holiday cheer to over 18,000 children



FY22 Recreation Center Funds Budget

- Many CRGs have not met regularly due to the pandemic. FY22 budgets were reviewed by CRGs where meetings were held
- FY22 RCF Budgets were prepared based on FY21 RCF Budget proposals with adjustments made as necessary by staff
- Funds are generated from class registration fees and permit surcharges

Equity in Recreation

- SD Access for All - SDPF supported Wi-Fi at 23 recreation centers in 2020-2021 with 35 more scheduled for 2021
- Mayors Proposed FY22 Budget allocates \$400,000 for equitable recreation within Communities of Concern
- San Diego Parks Foundation Come Play Outside Initiative for Communities of Concern
- County of San Diego funding \$750,000 toward Come Play Outside programs and events
- Price Charities is donating \$150,000 to support programs and events
